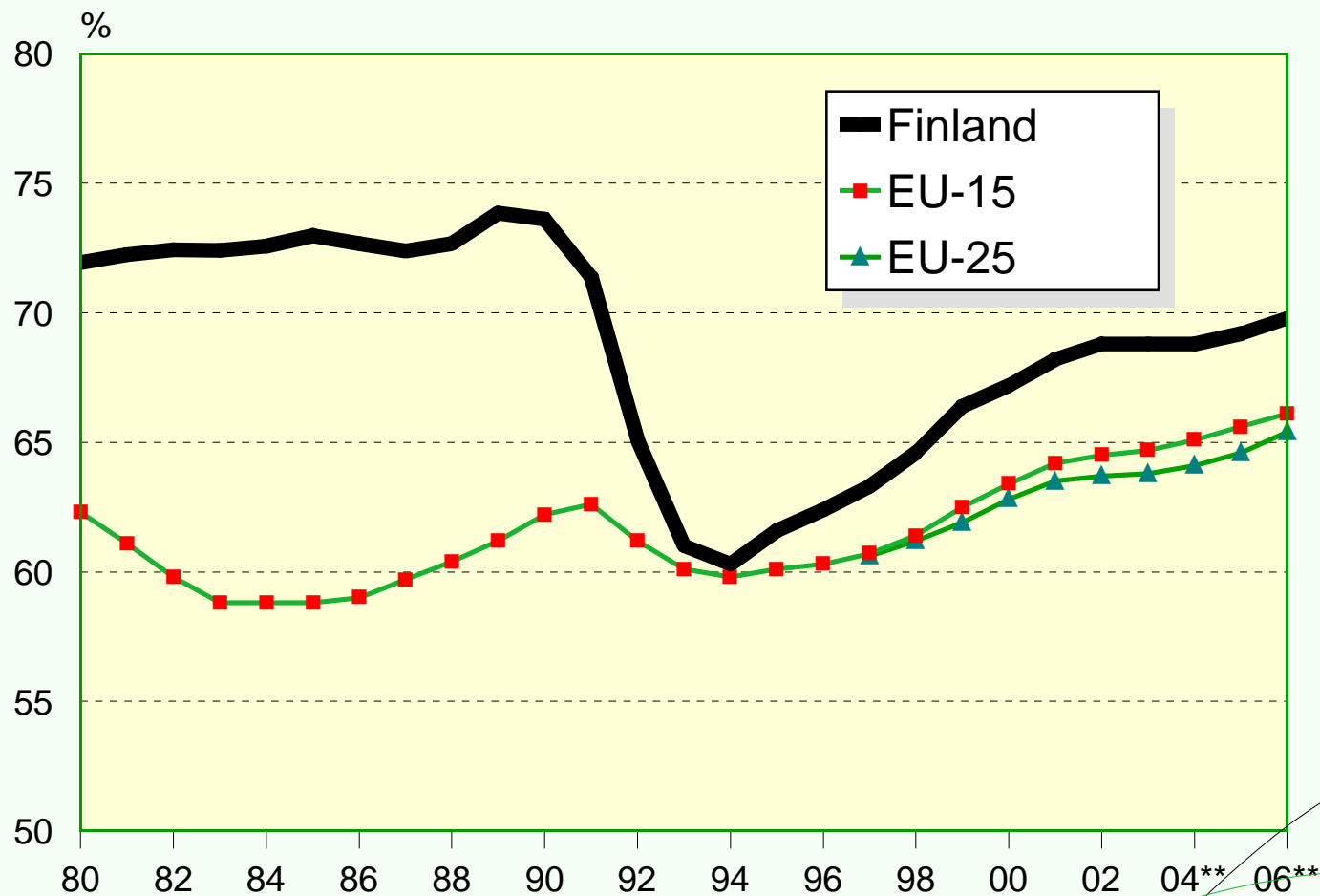
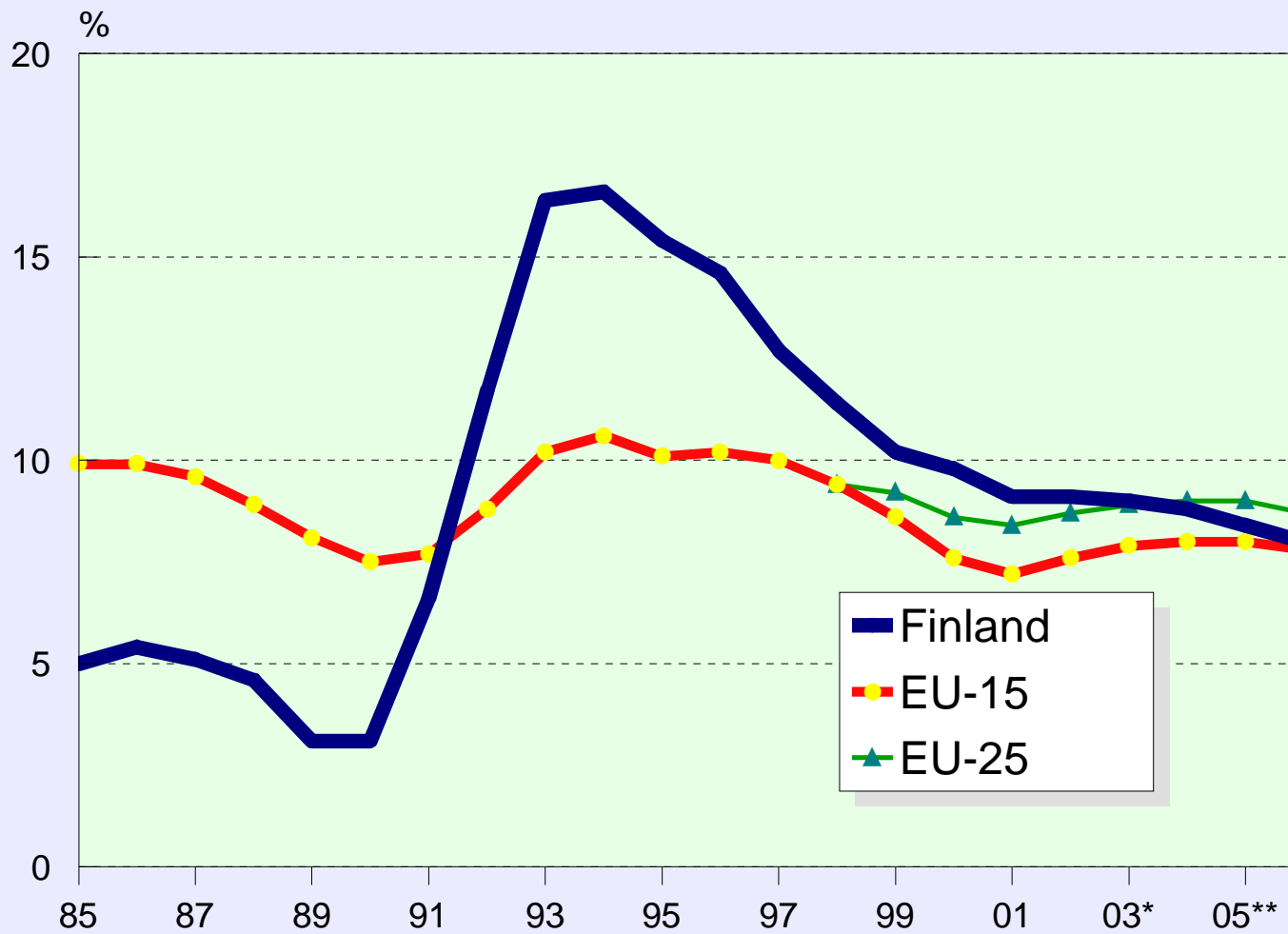


EMPLOYMENT RATE 1980 - 2006

Employed/Working age population (15 - 64 years)

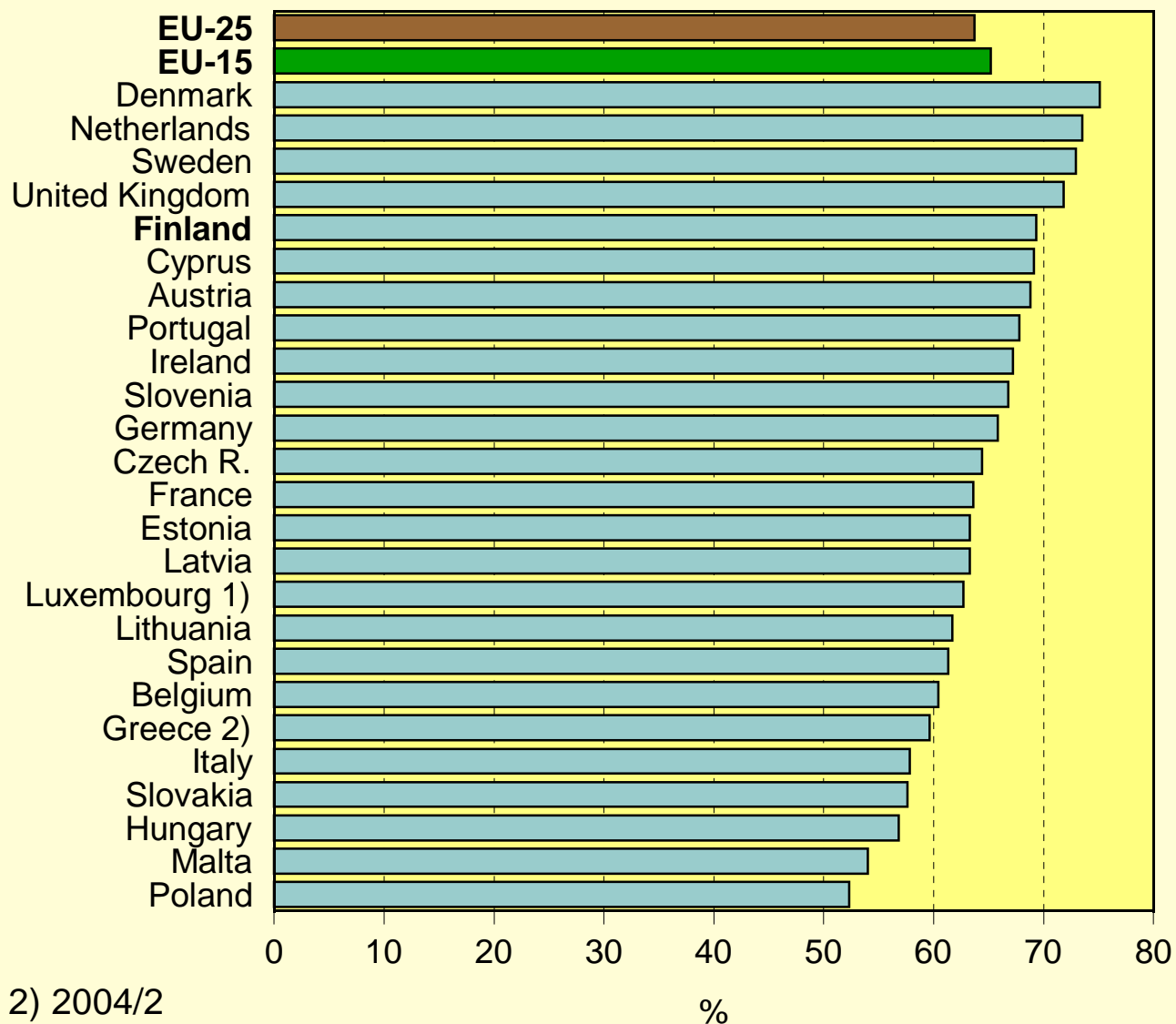


UNEMPLOYMENT RATE 1985 - 2006



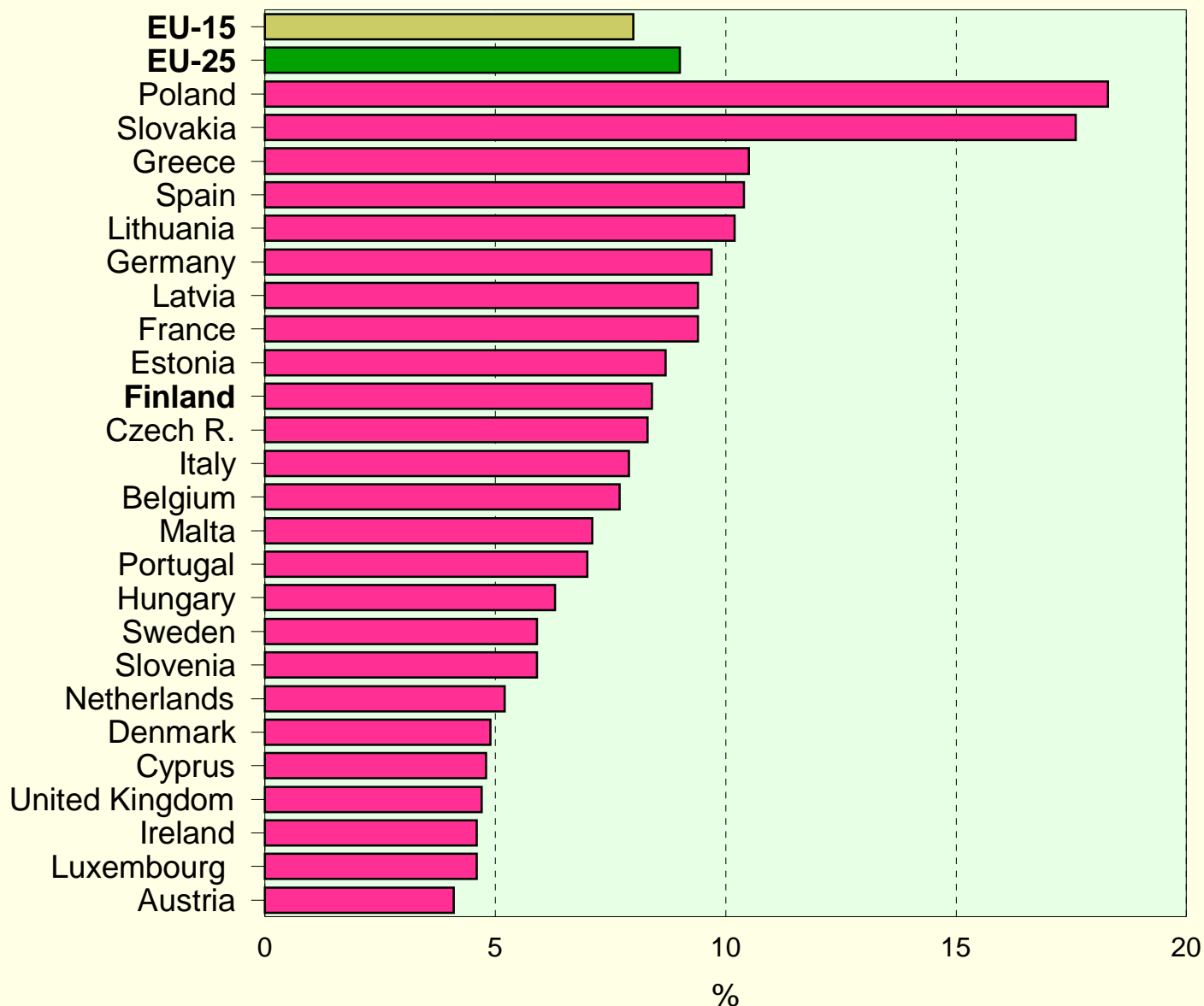
EMPLOYMENT RATE IN EU-COUNTRIES 2004, Q3

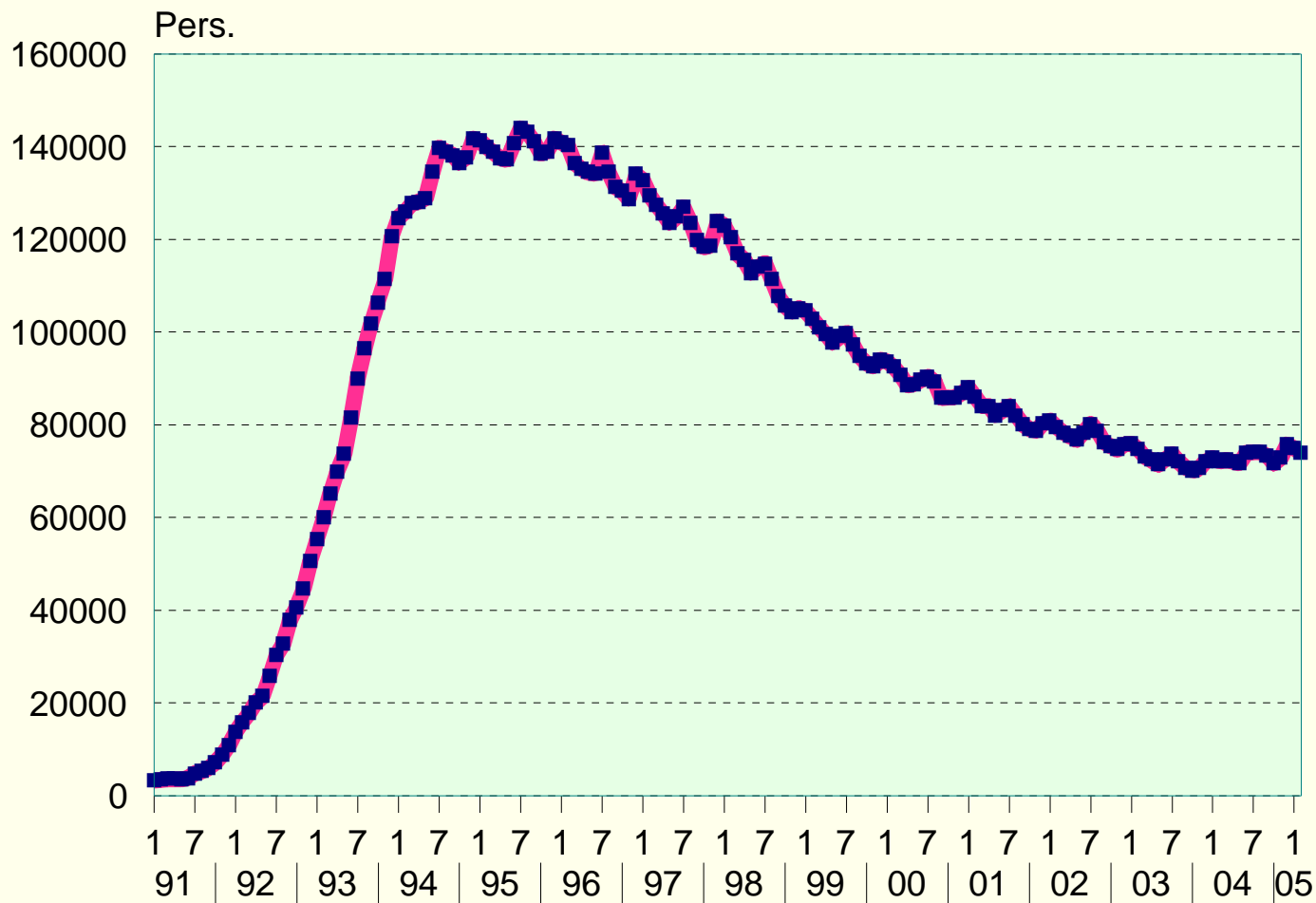

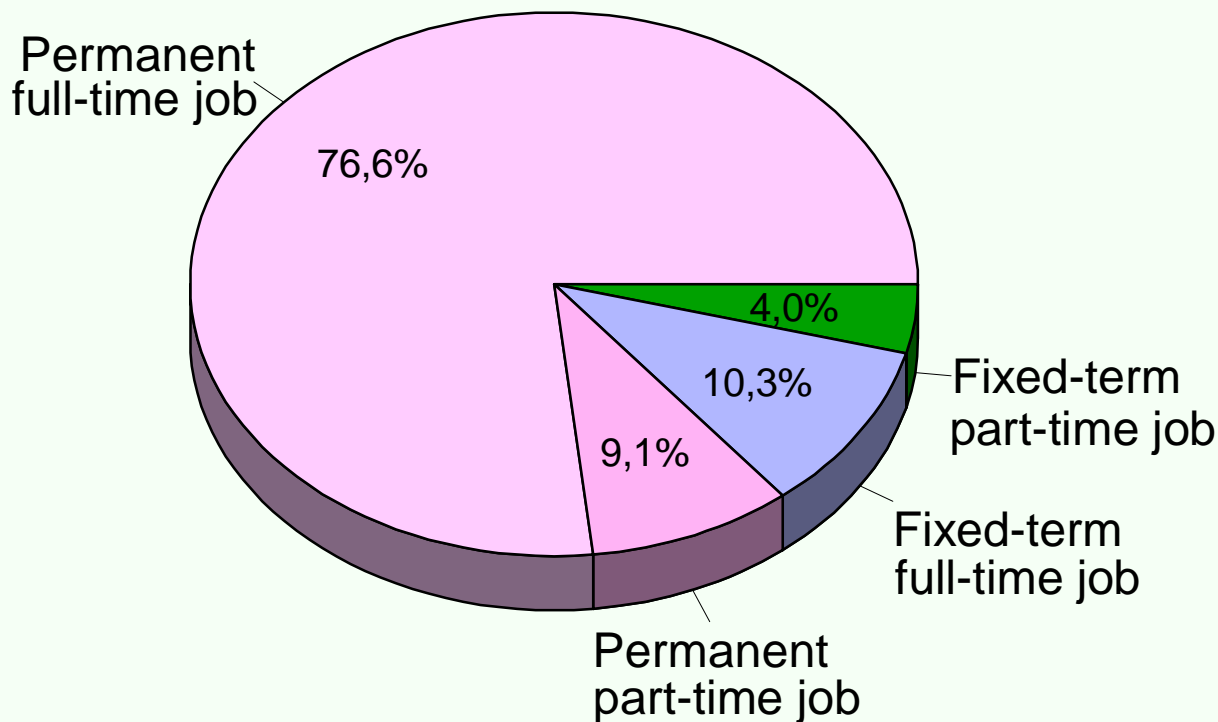
UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN EU-COUNTRIES 2005



LONG-TERM UNEMPLOYED 1991 - 2005:2



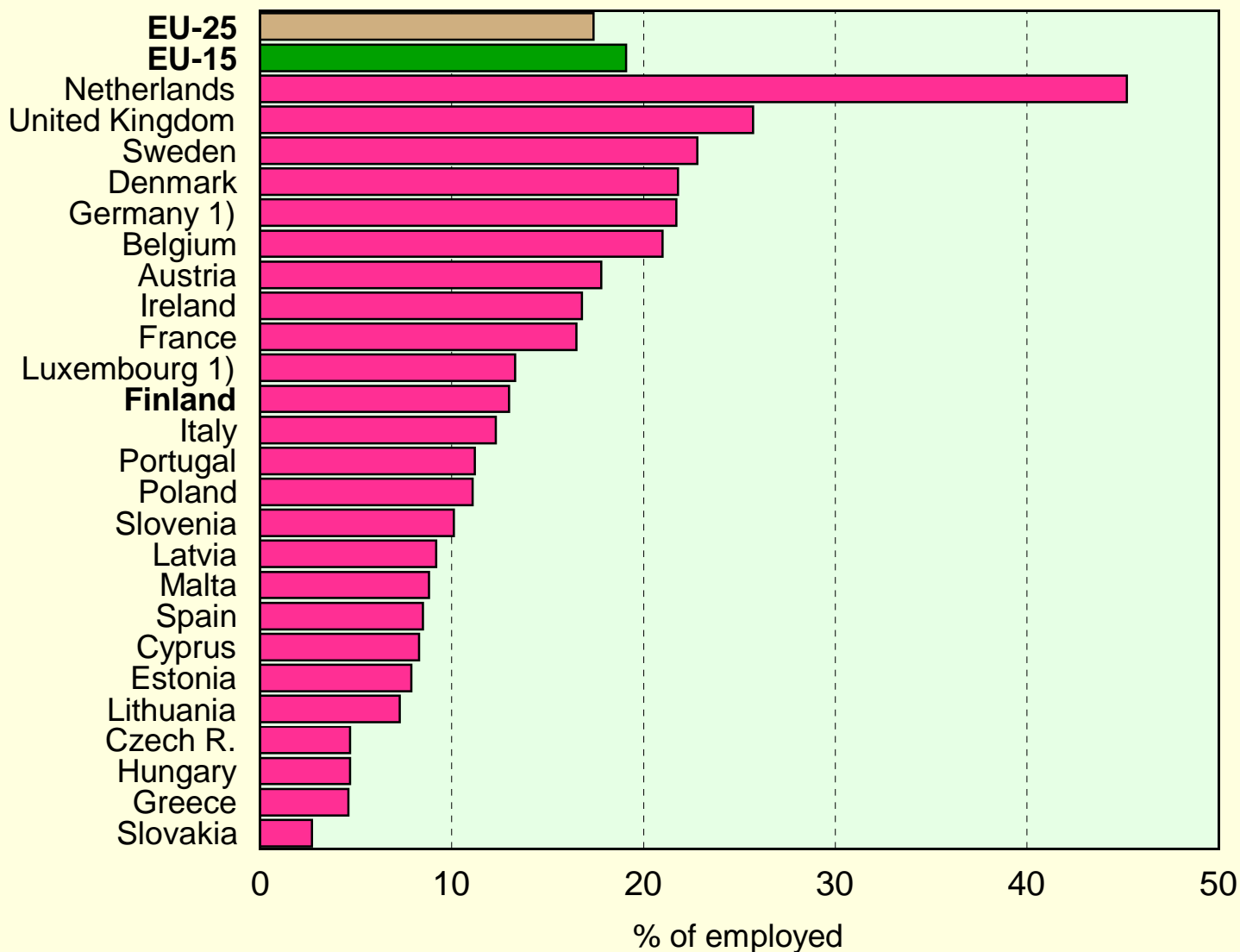

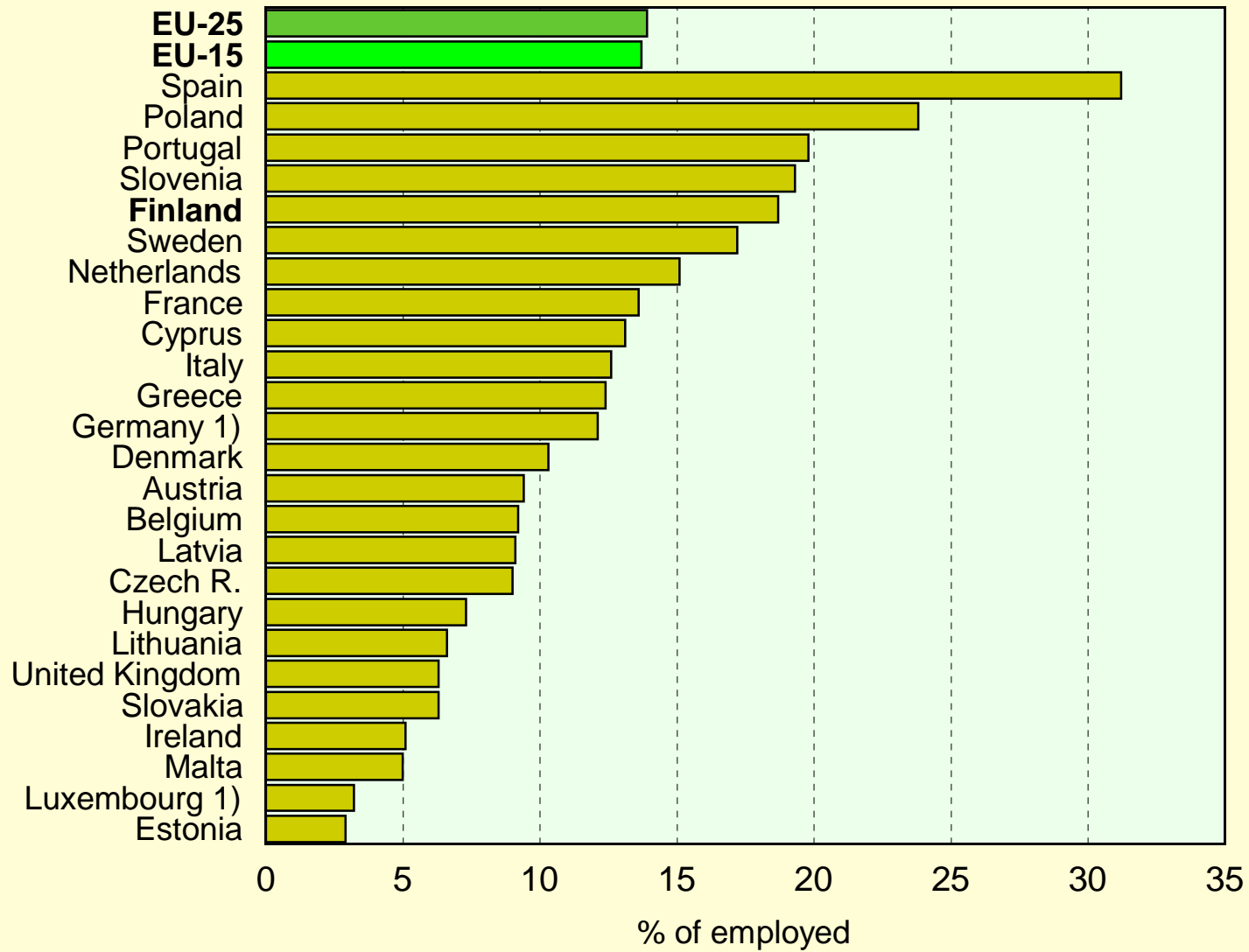

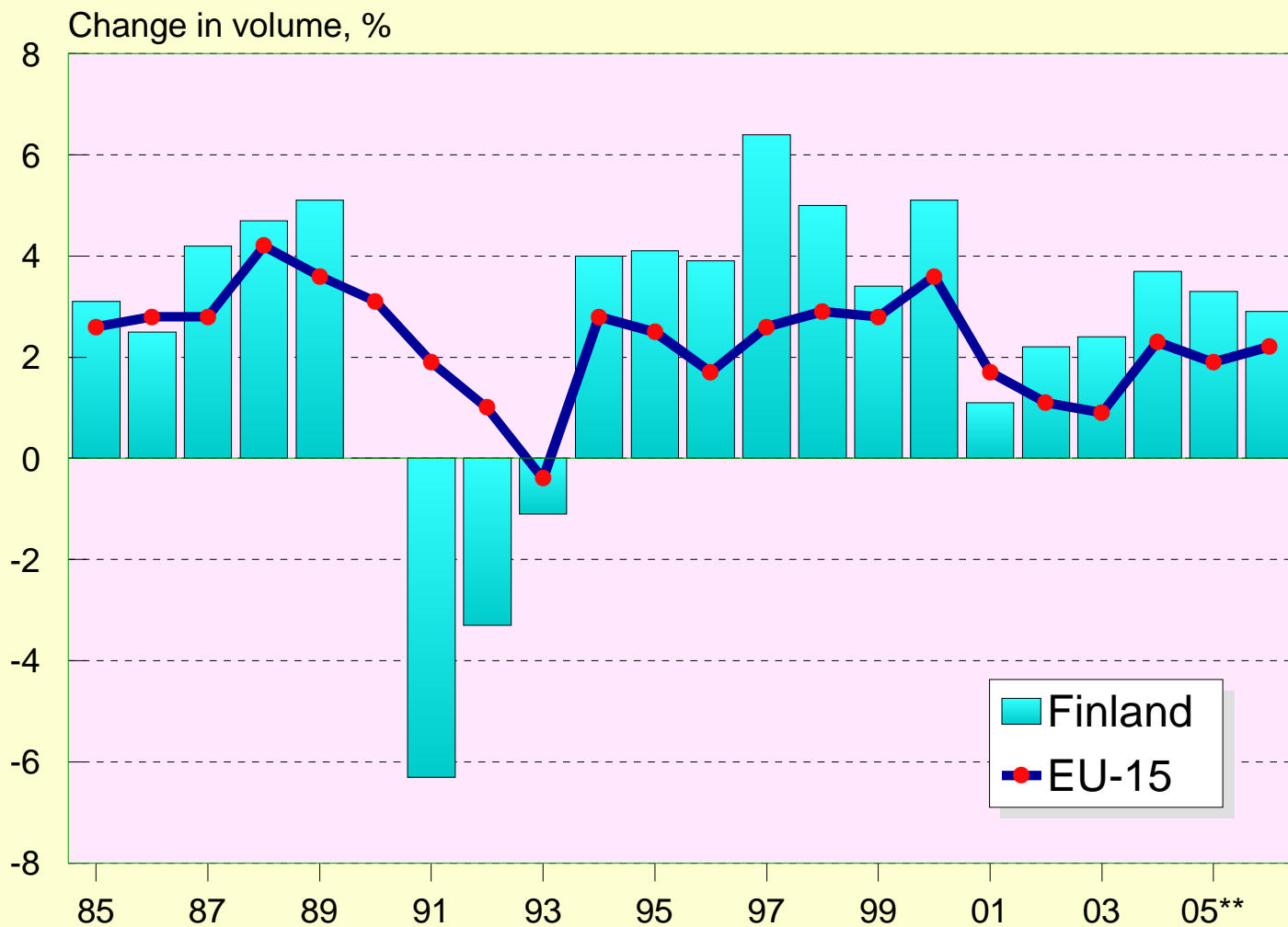

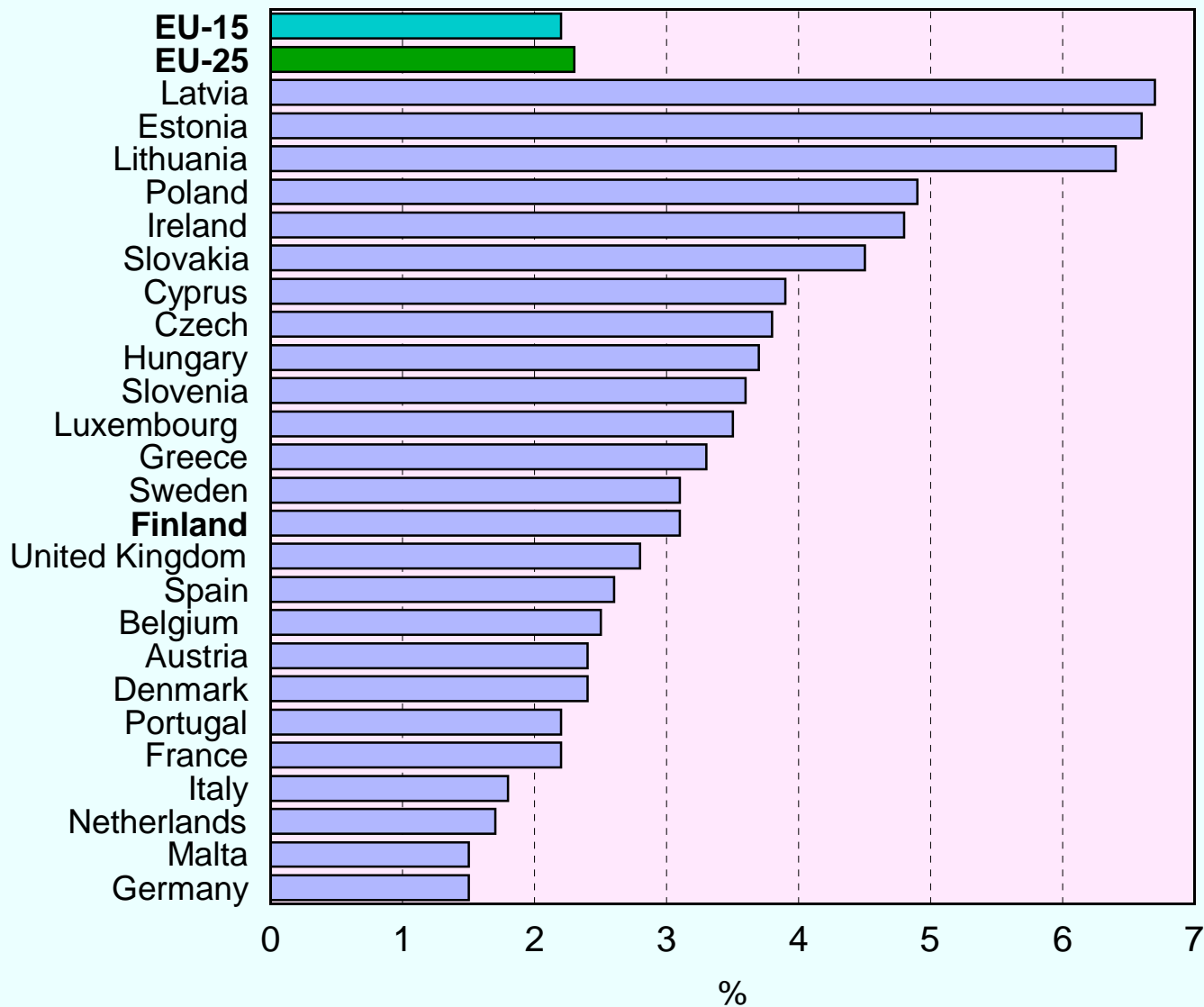

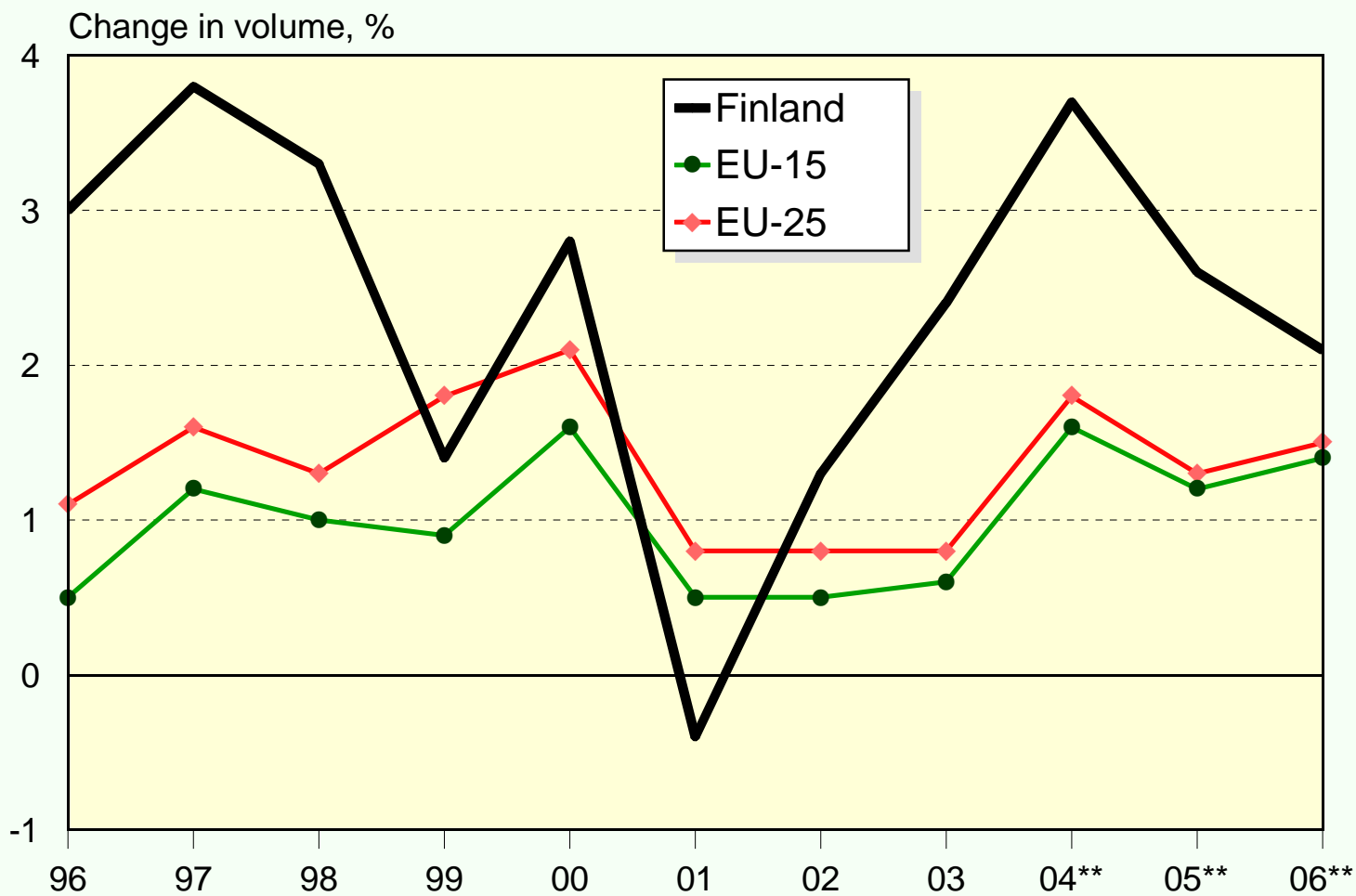
GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT 1985 - 2005



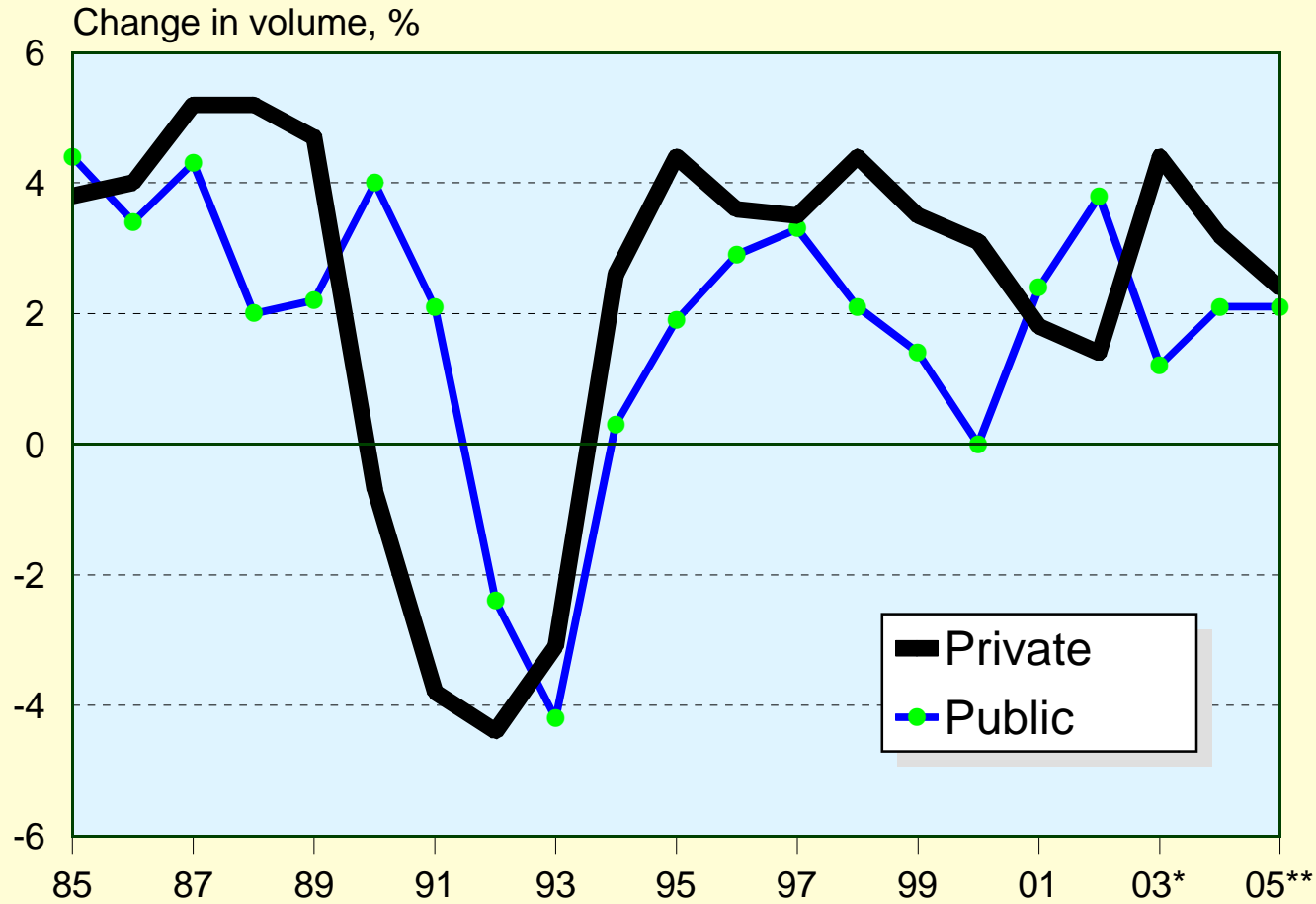
GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT IN EU-COUNTRIES 2005**



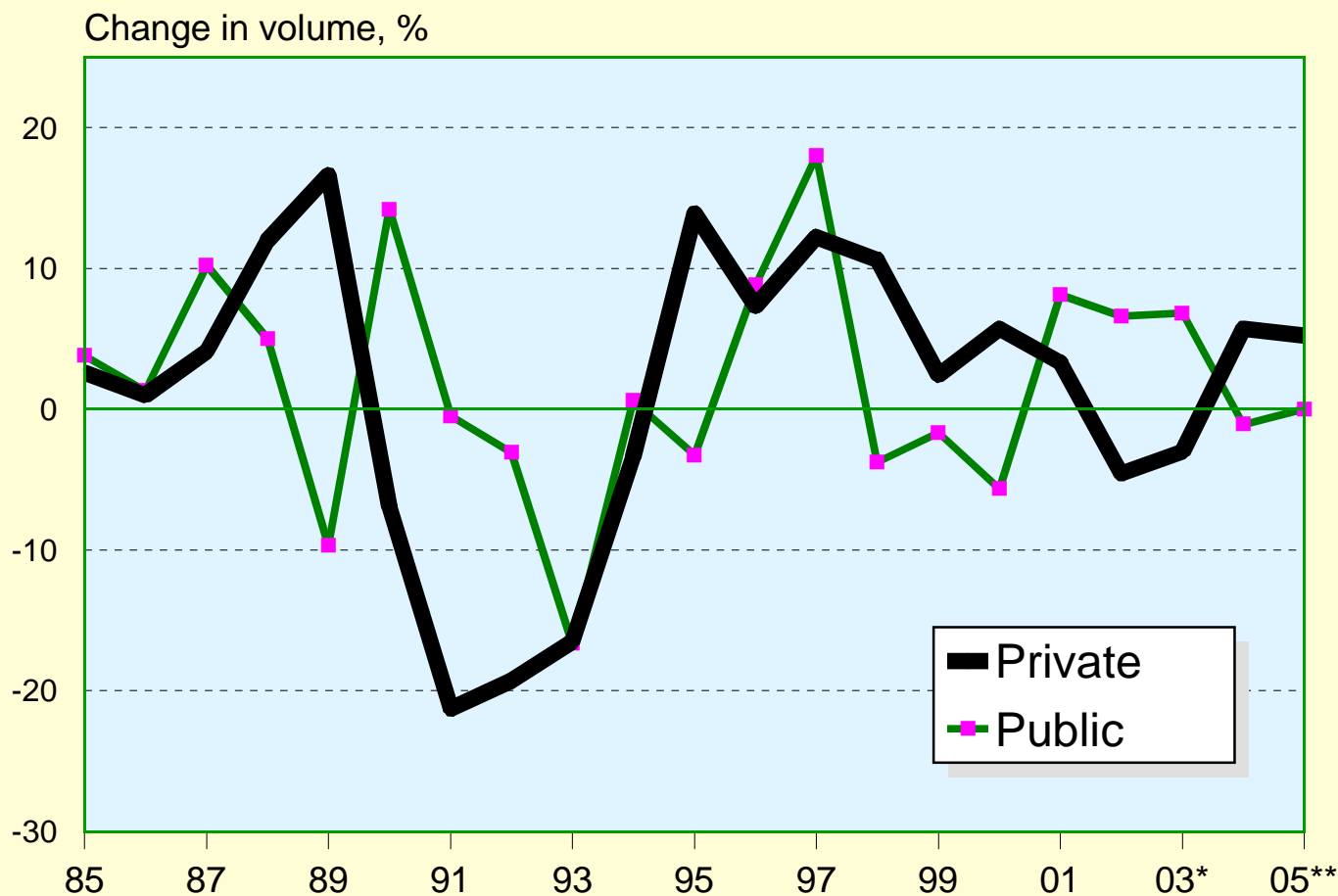
LABOUR PRODUCTIVITY 1996 - 2006



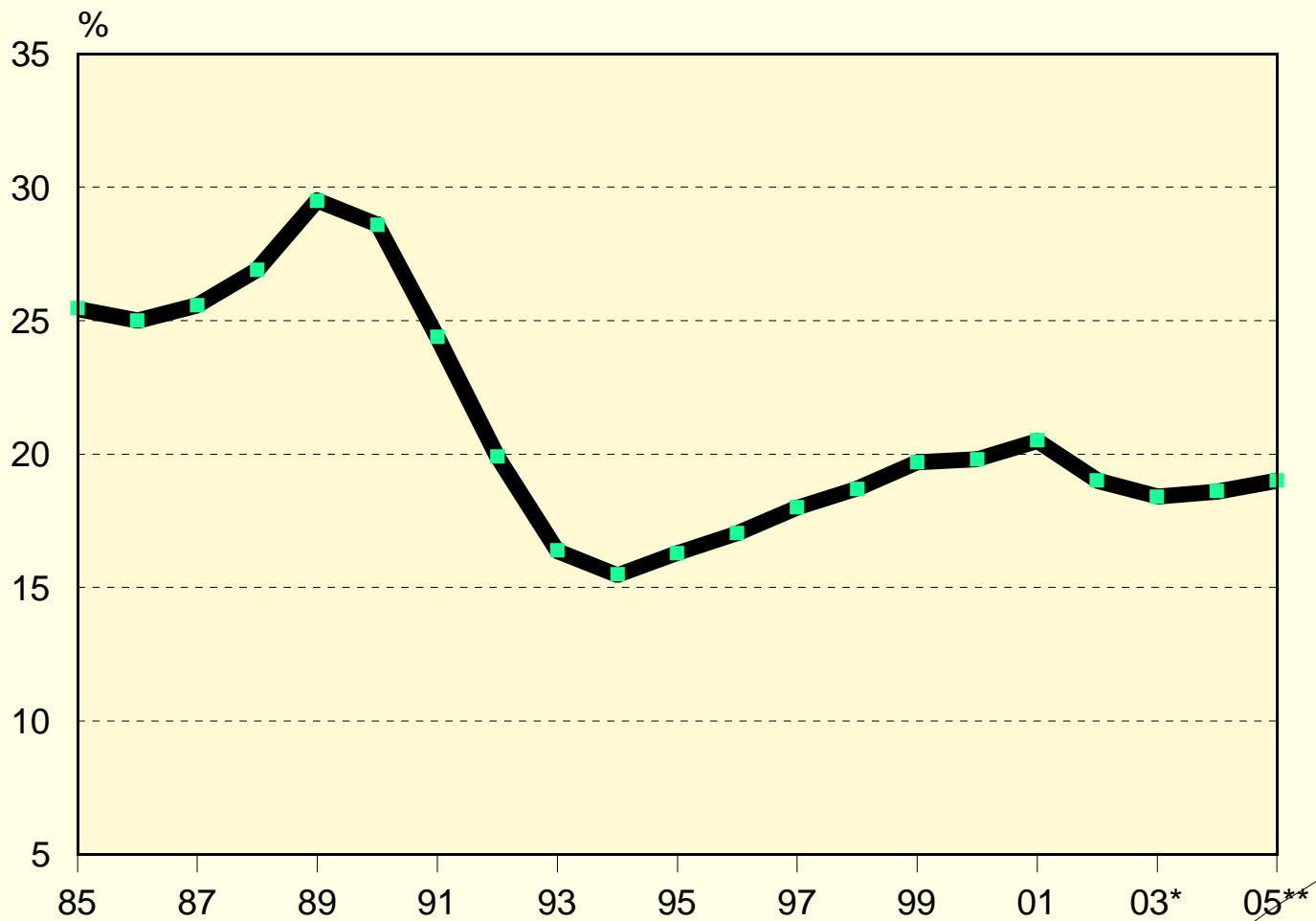

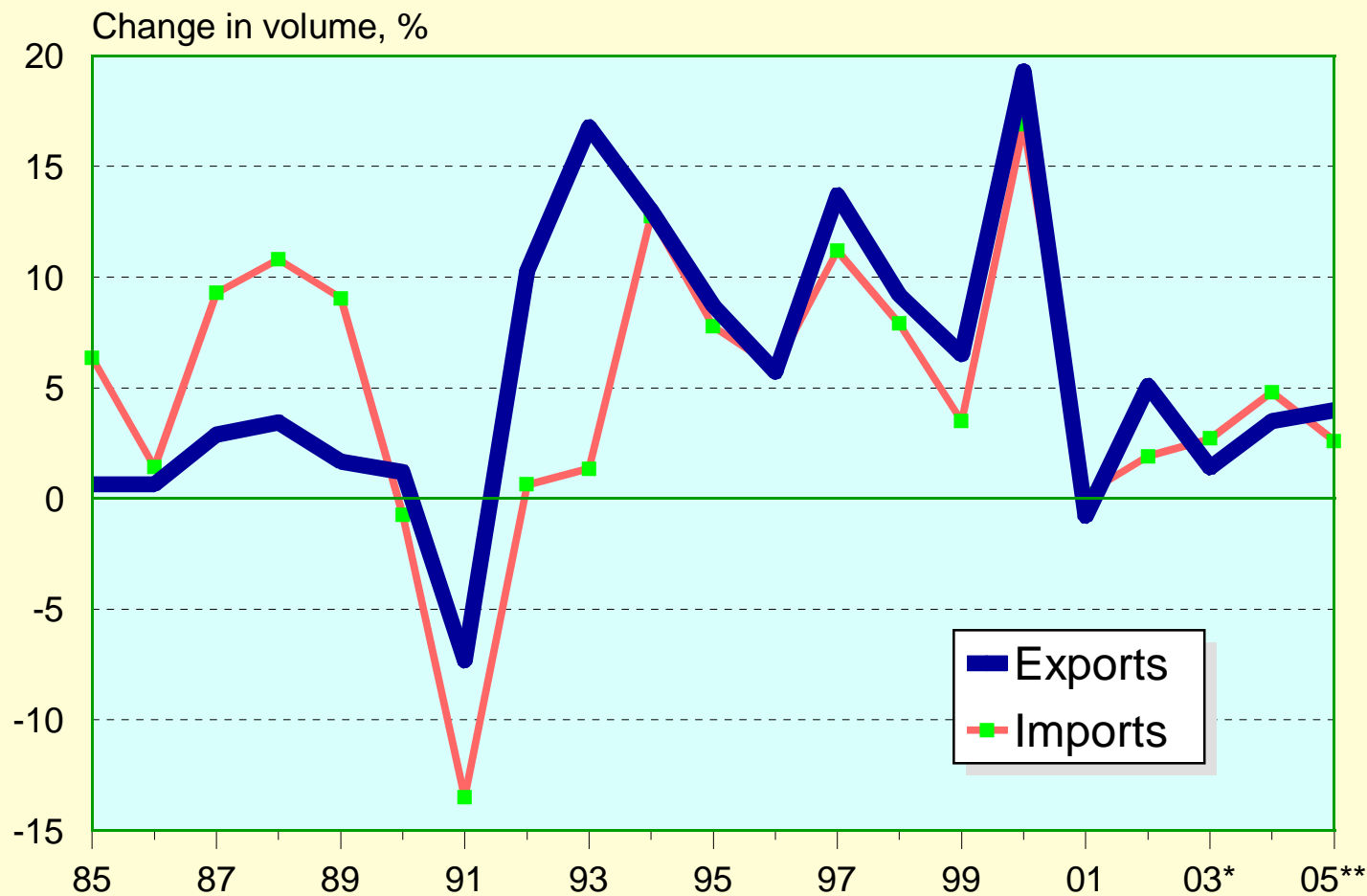

RATIO OF INVESTMENTS TO GDP 1985 - 2005

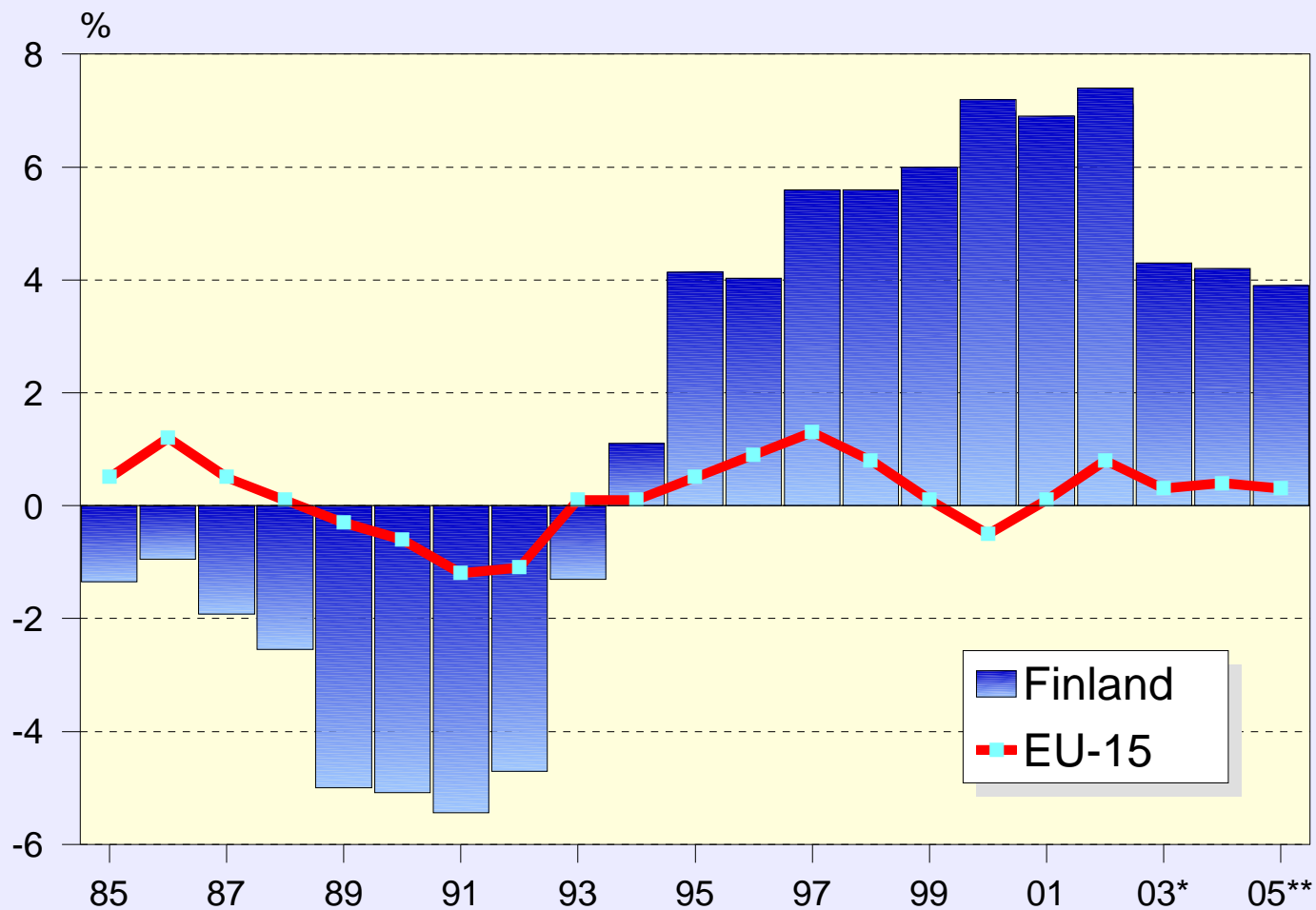


IMPORTS AND EXPORTS OF GOODS AND SERVICES, 1985 - 2005

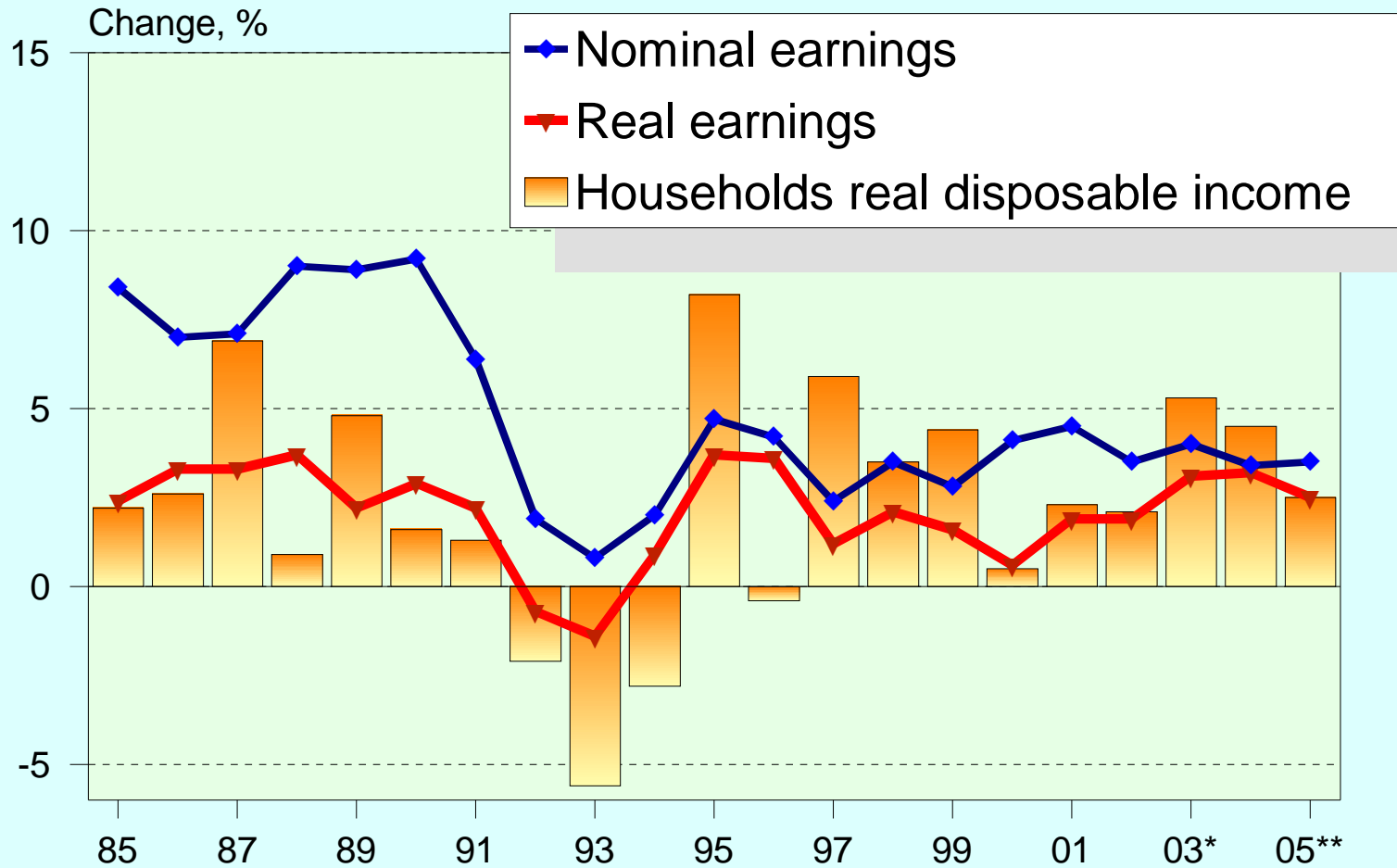

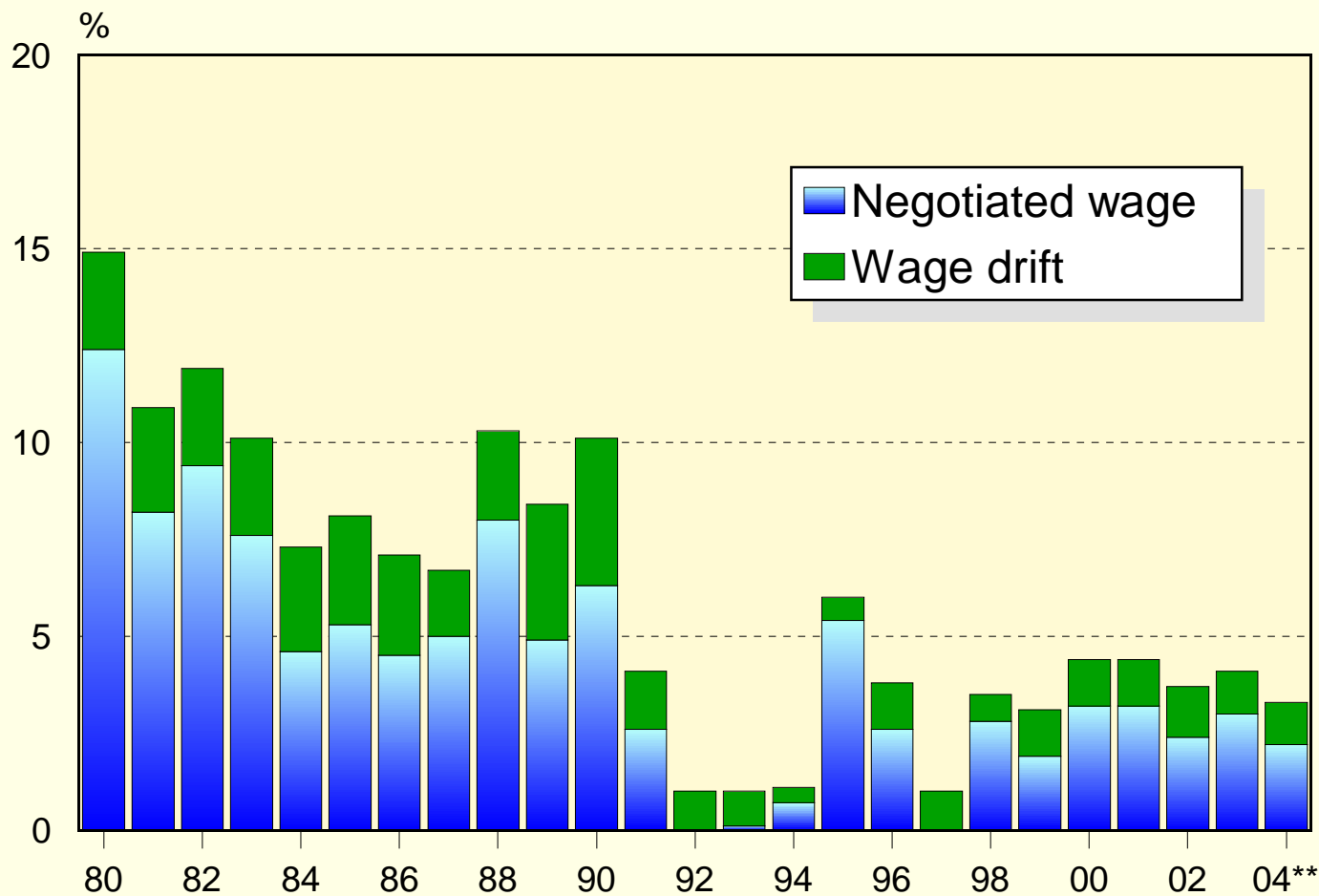

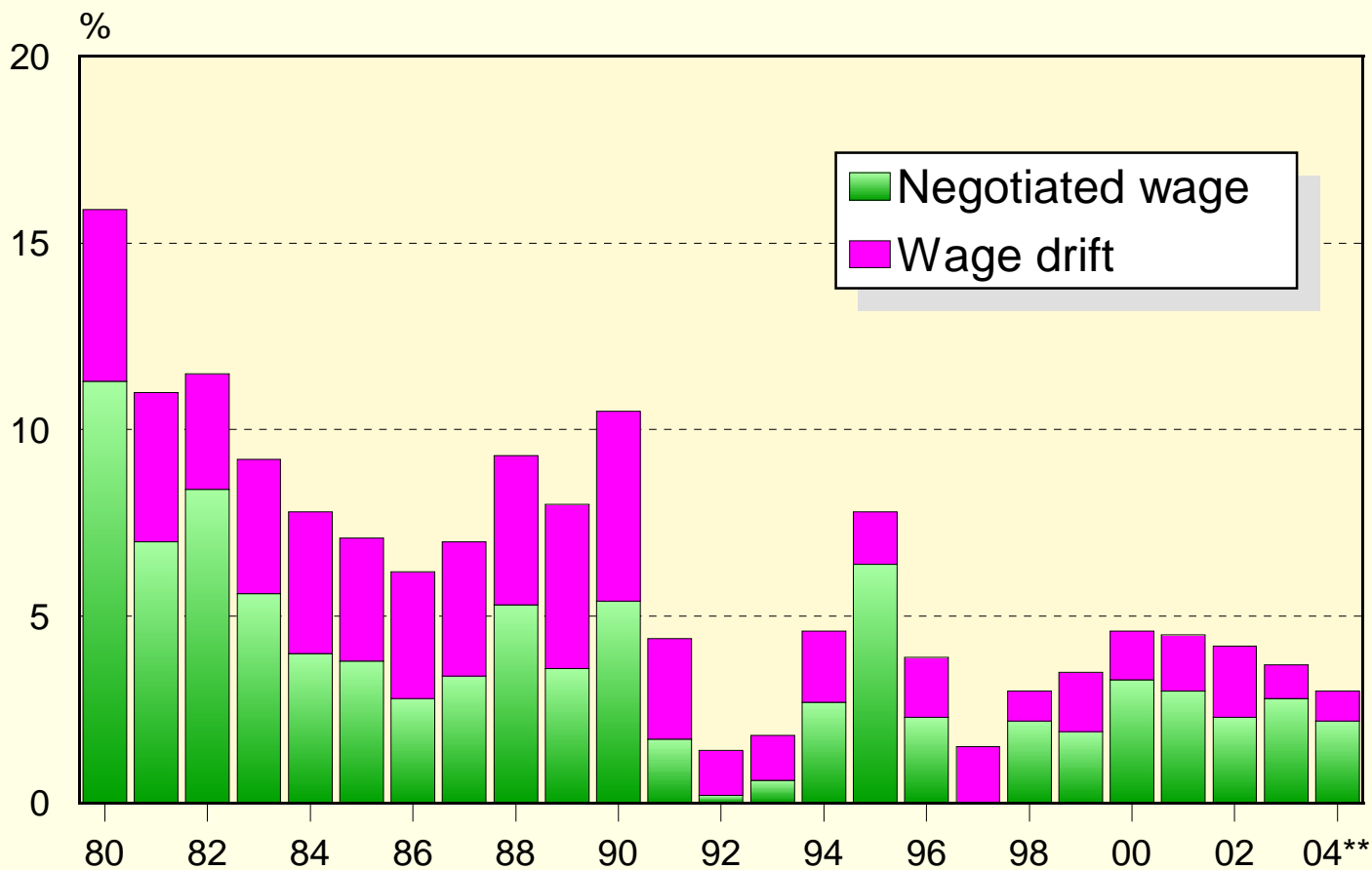

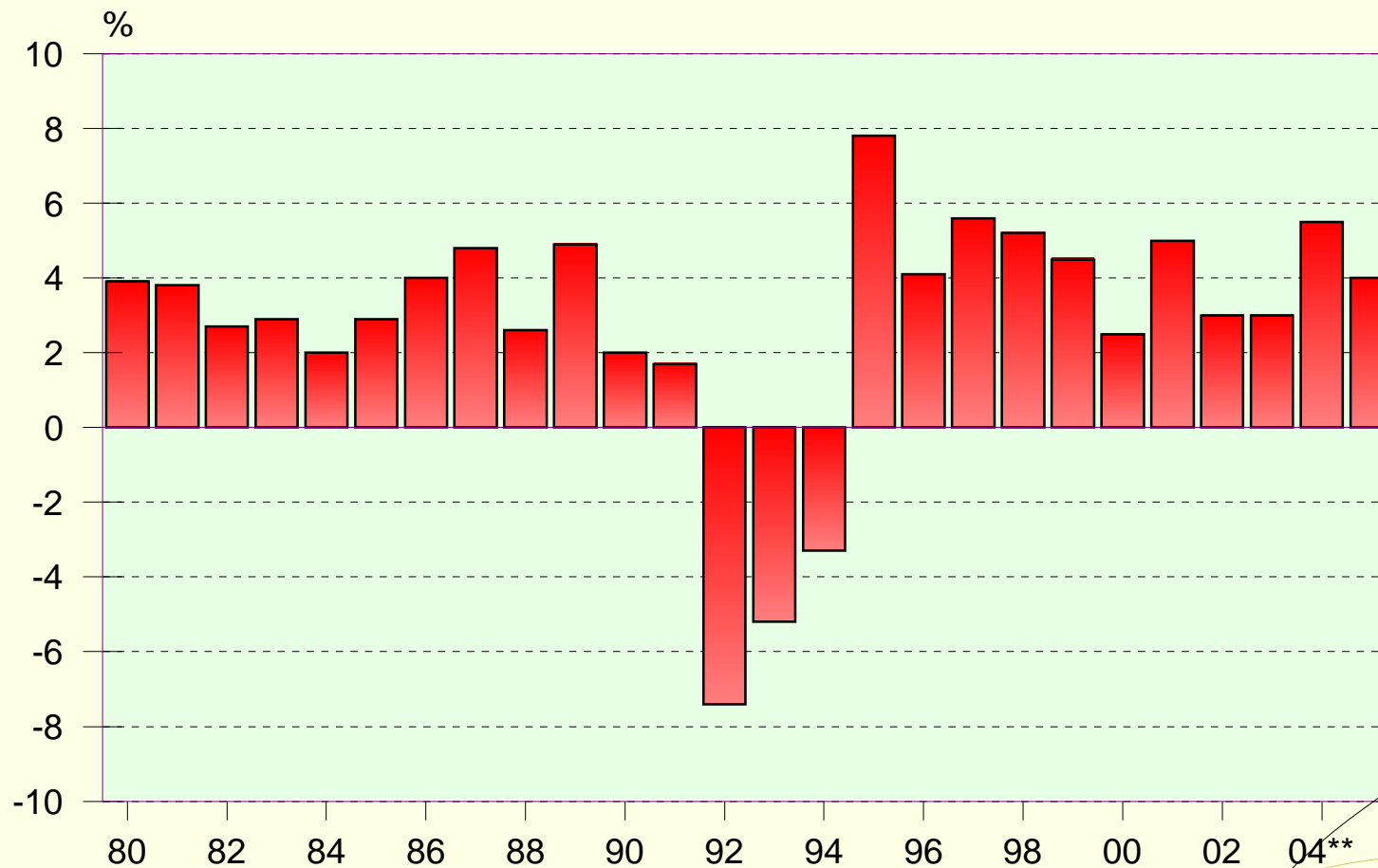


WAGES AND SALARIES 1975 - 2004, Q4 - Q4 Manufacturing workers

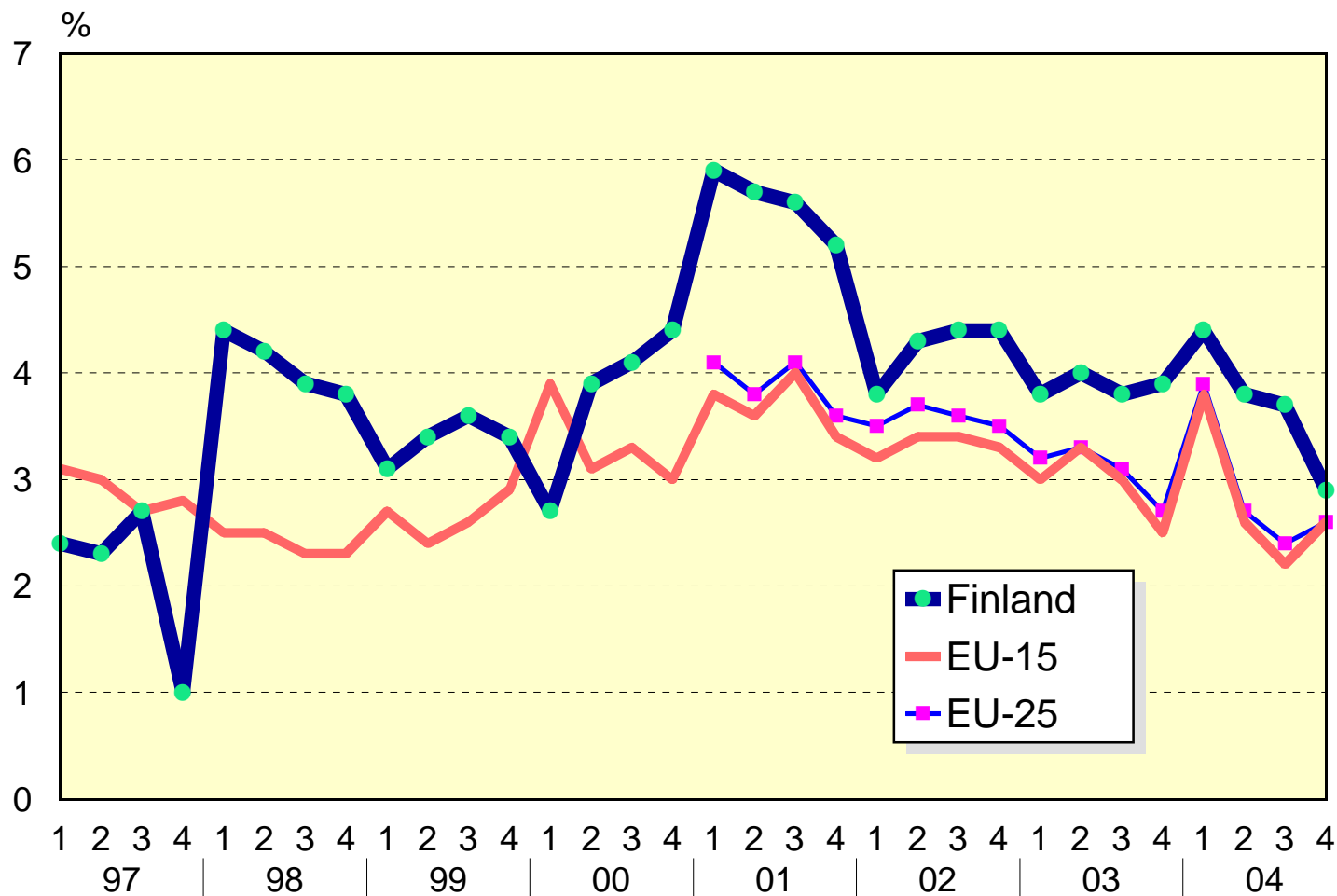

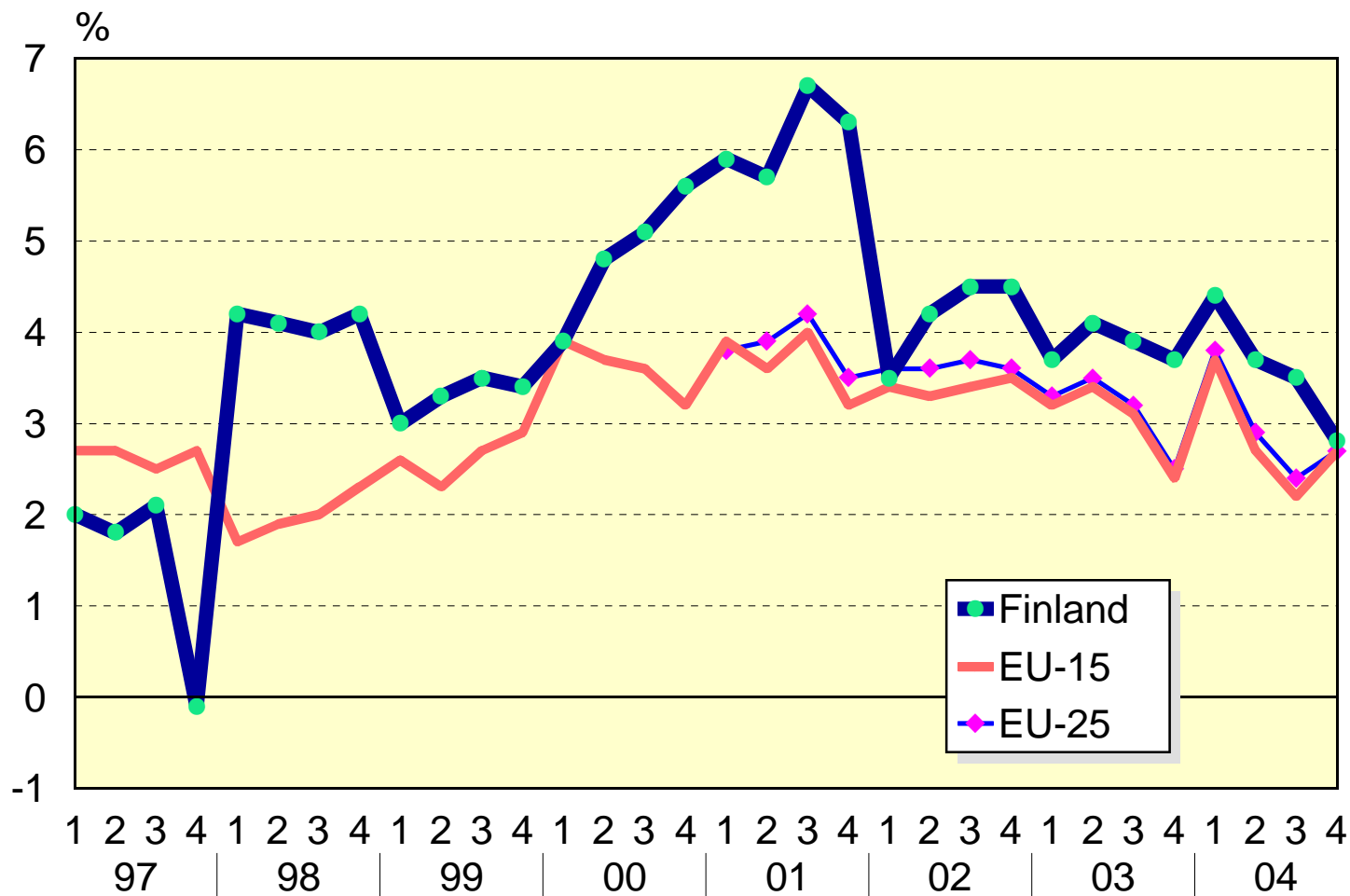

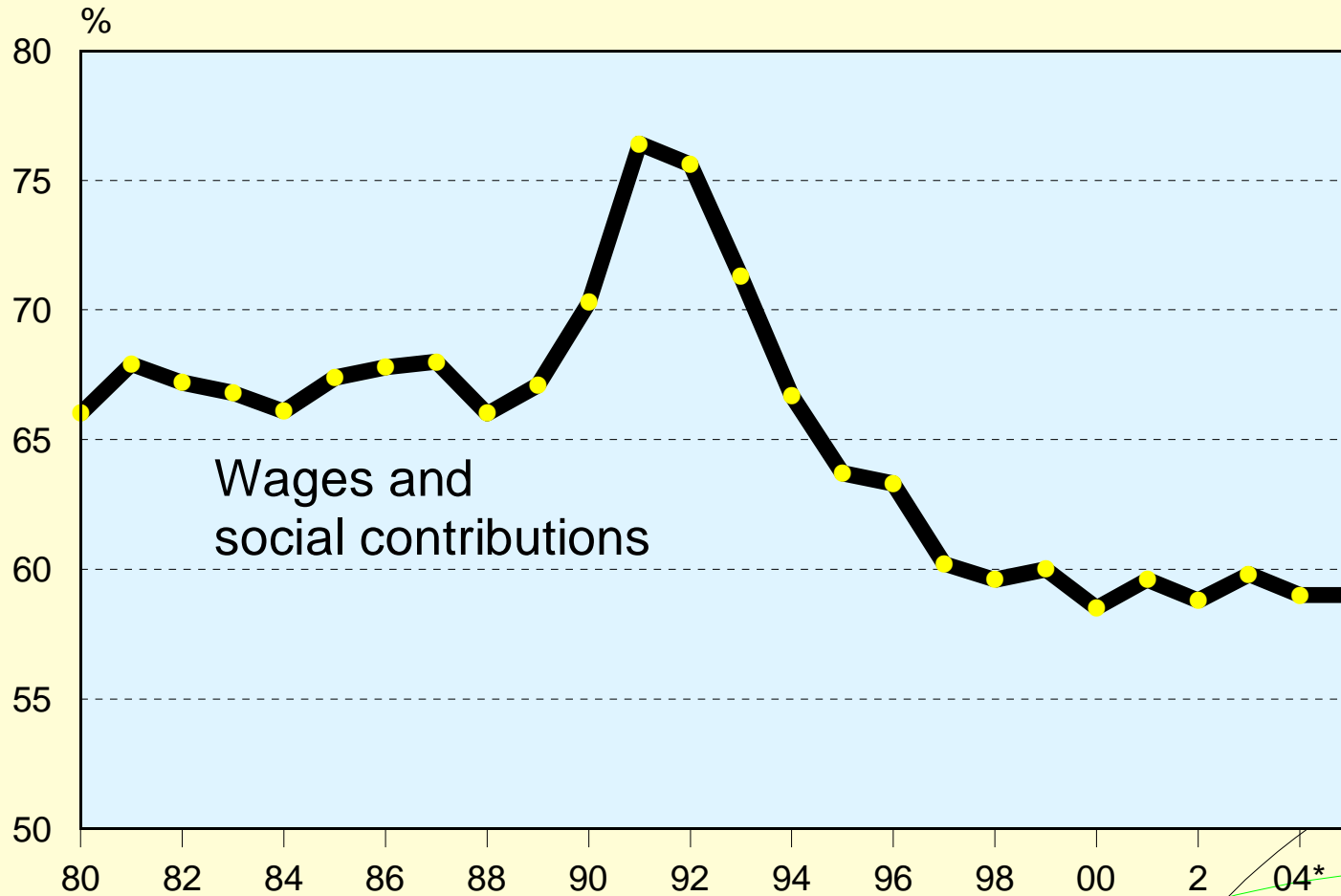
TOTAL NOMINAL LABOUR COSTS (private sector) 1997-2004, change compared to same quarter a year earlier

change compared to same quarter a year earlier

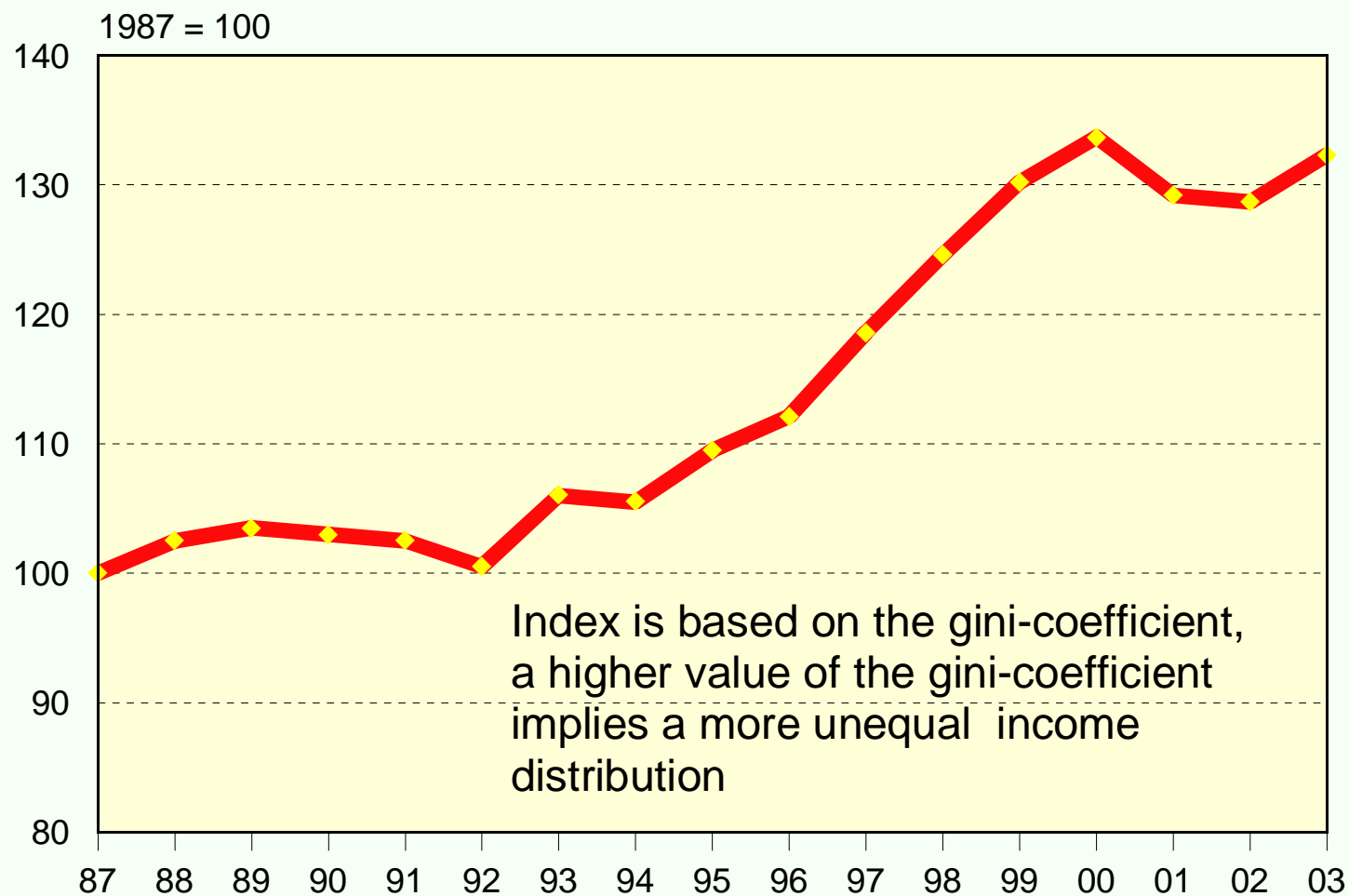


LABOUR INCOME AS A PERCENTAGE OF NATIONAL INCOME 1980 - 2005

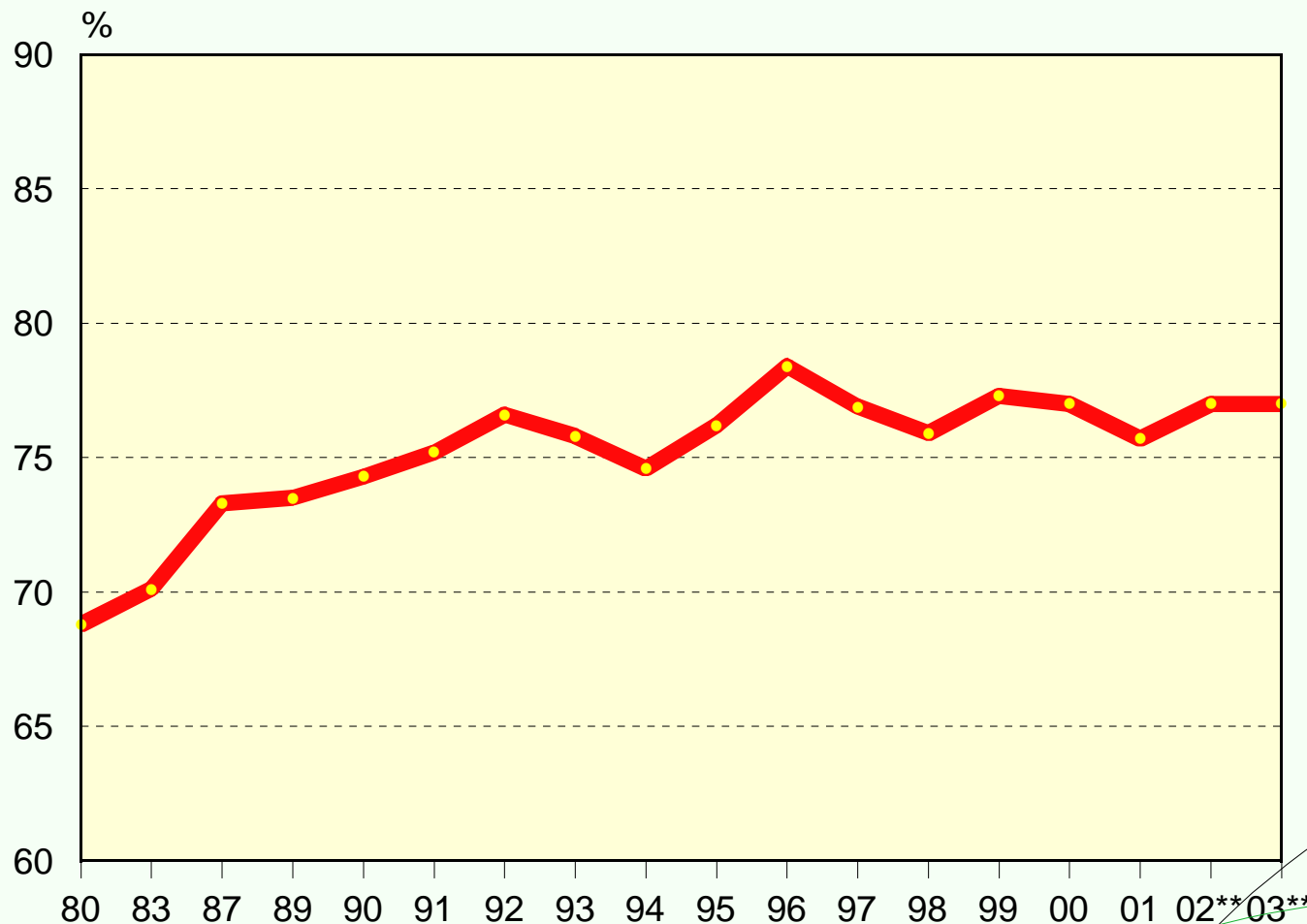


INCOME DIFFERENCES BETWEEN HOUSEHOLDS 1987 - 2003

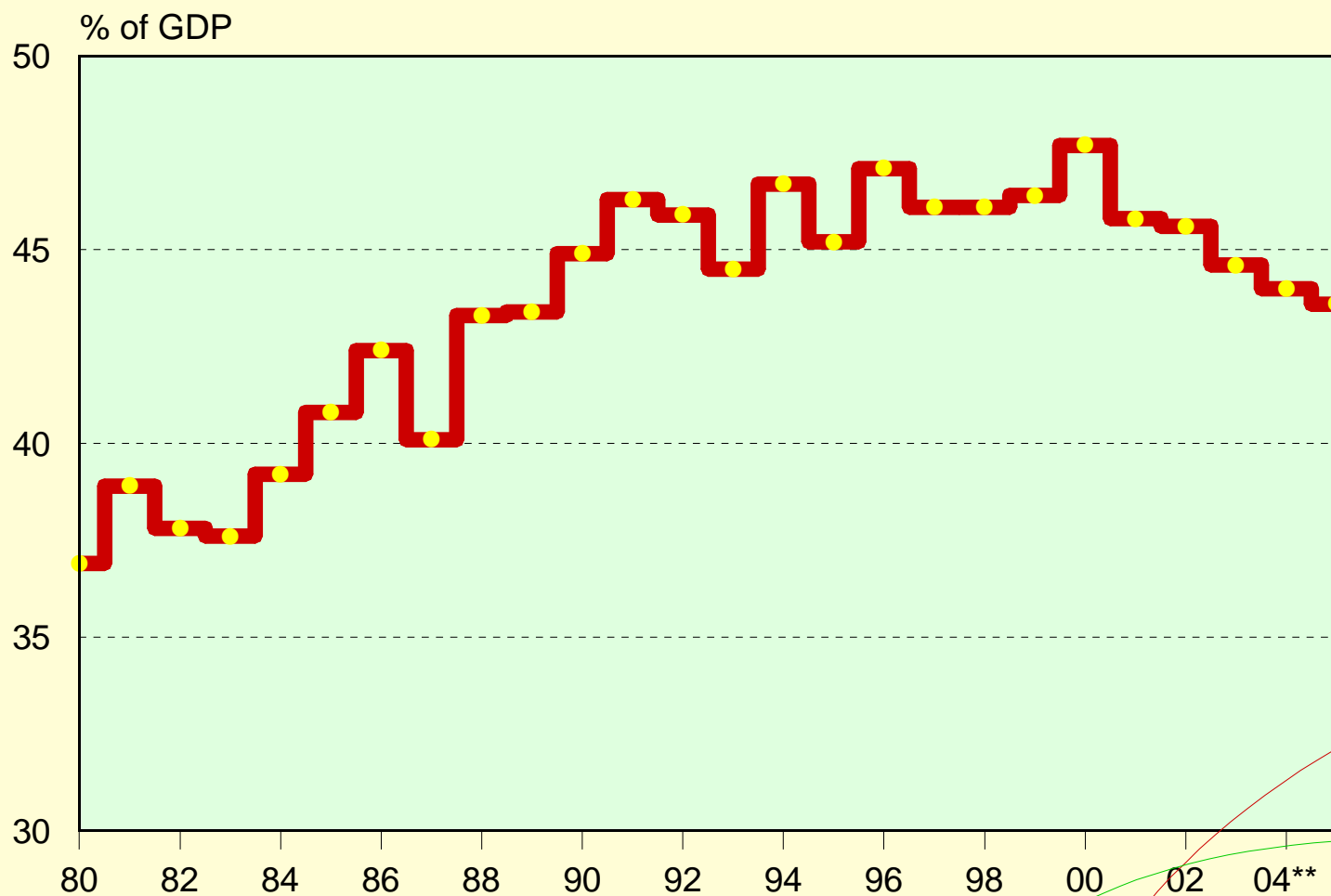

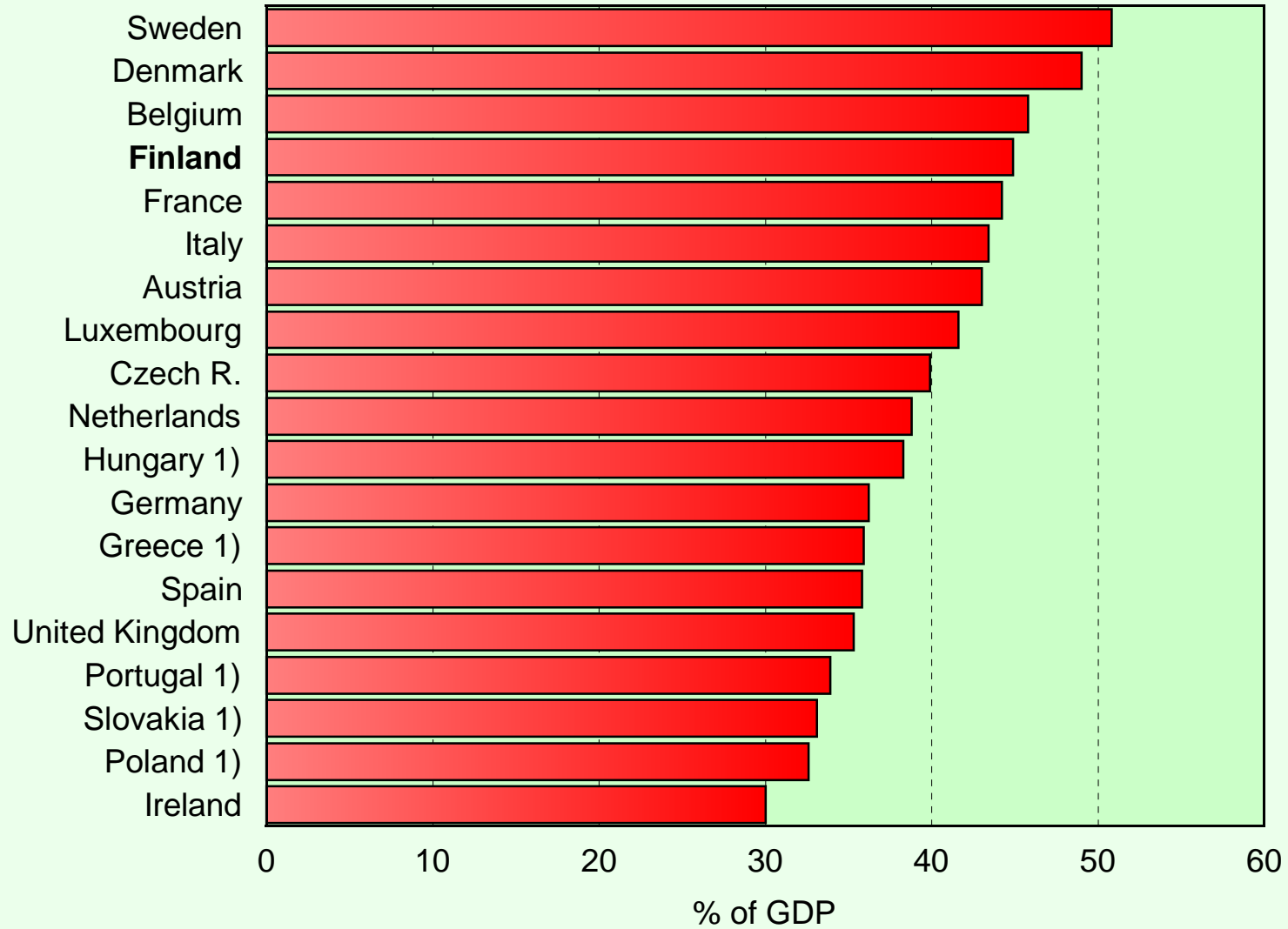
WOMENS' ANNUAL EARNINGS AS A PERCENTAGE OF MENS' ANNUAL EARNINGS 1980 - 2003



TAX RATE 1980 - 2005



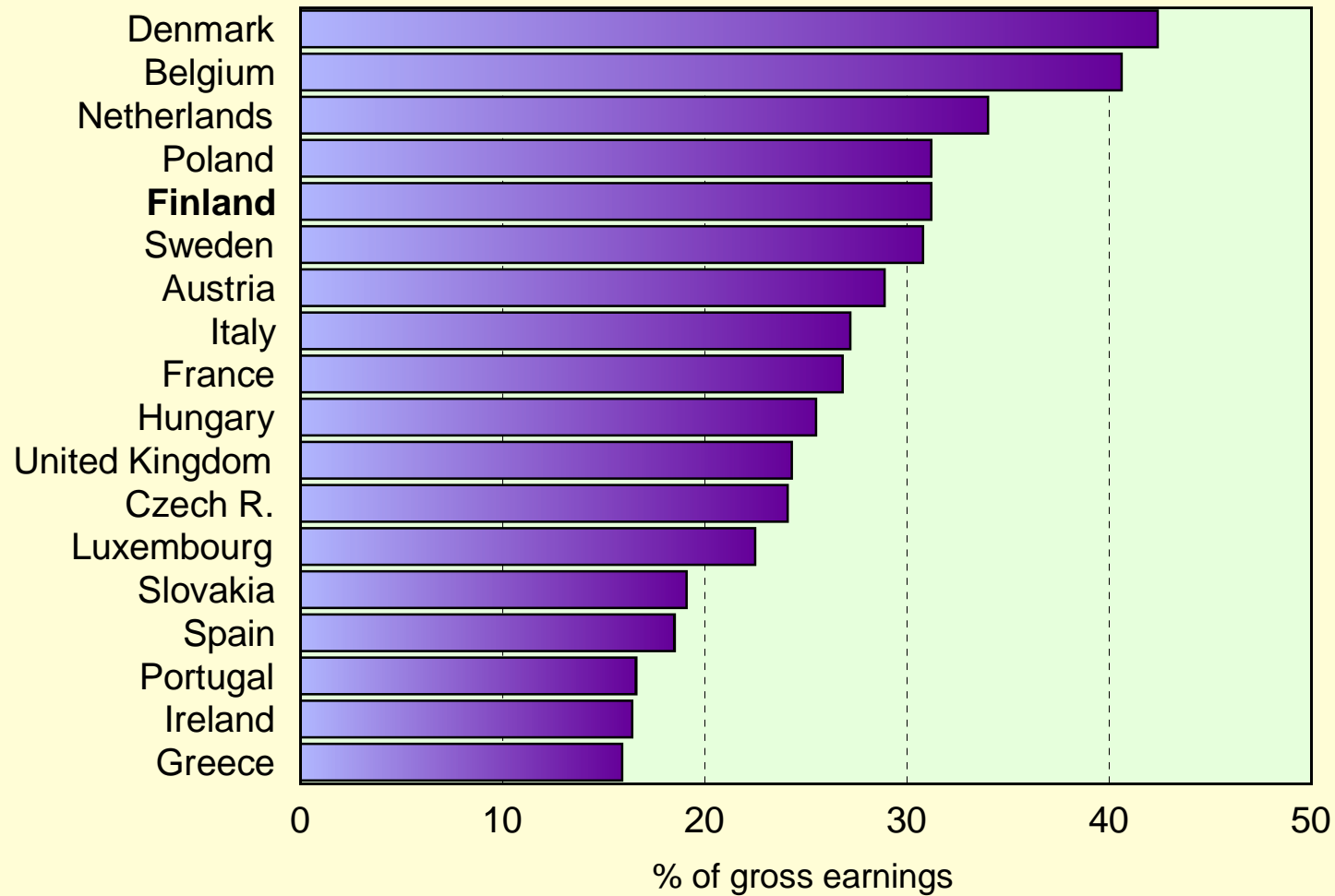
TAX RATE IN SOME COUNTRIES 2003

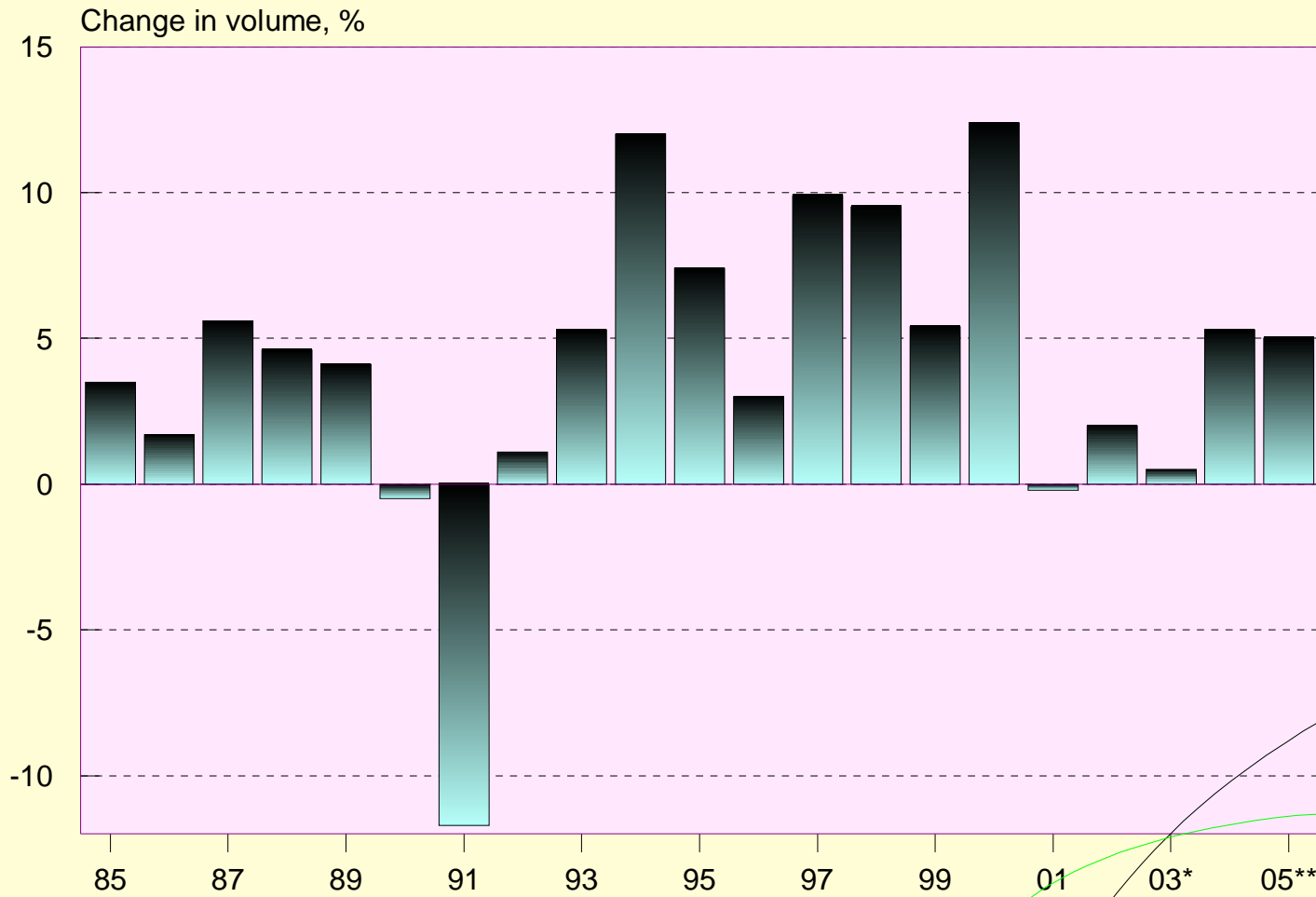

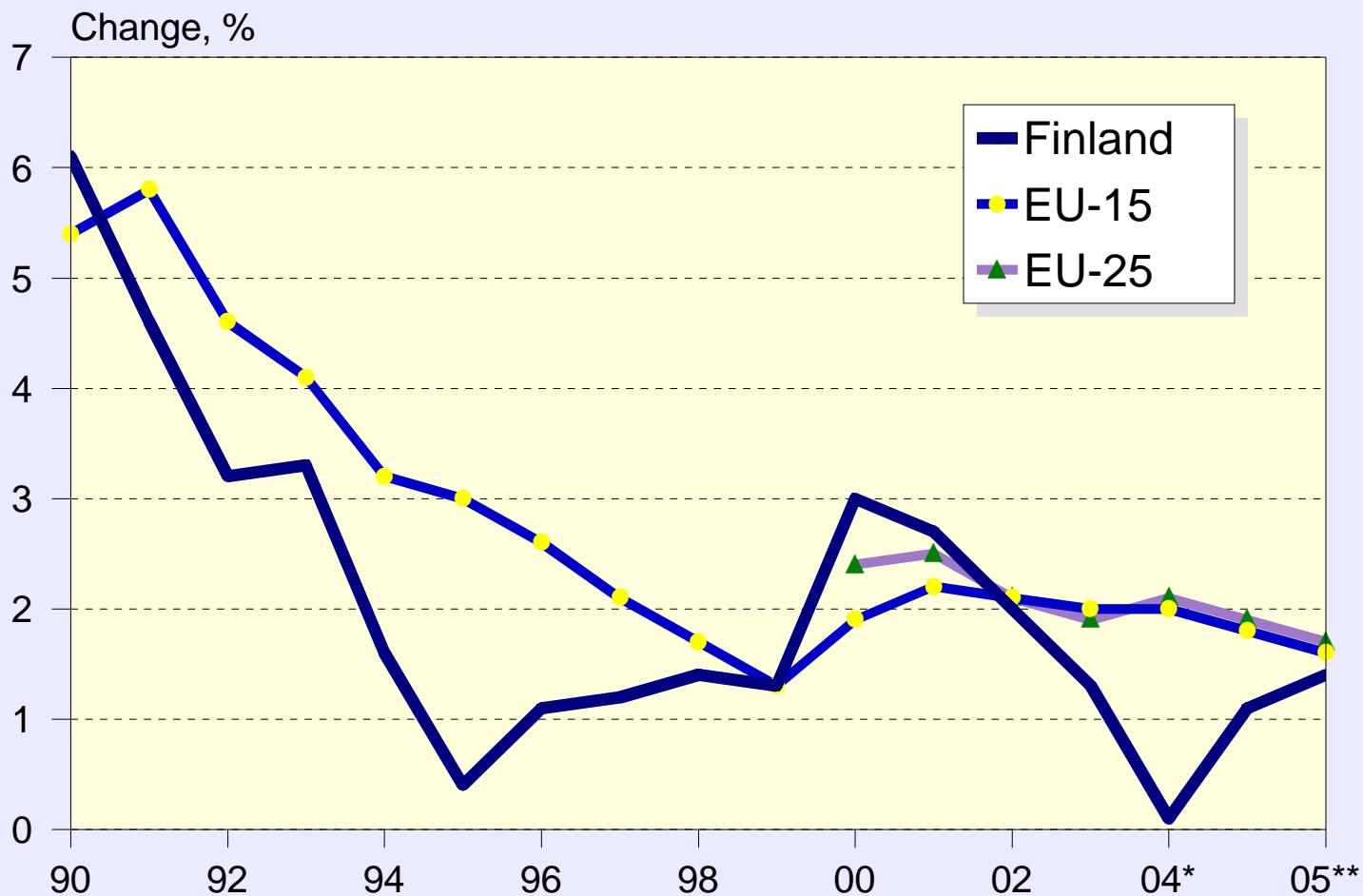

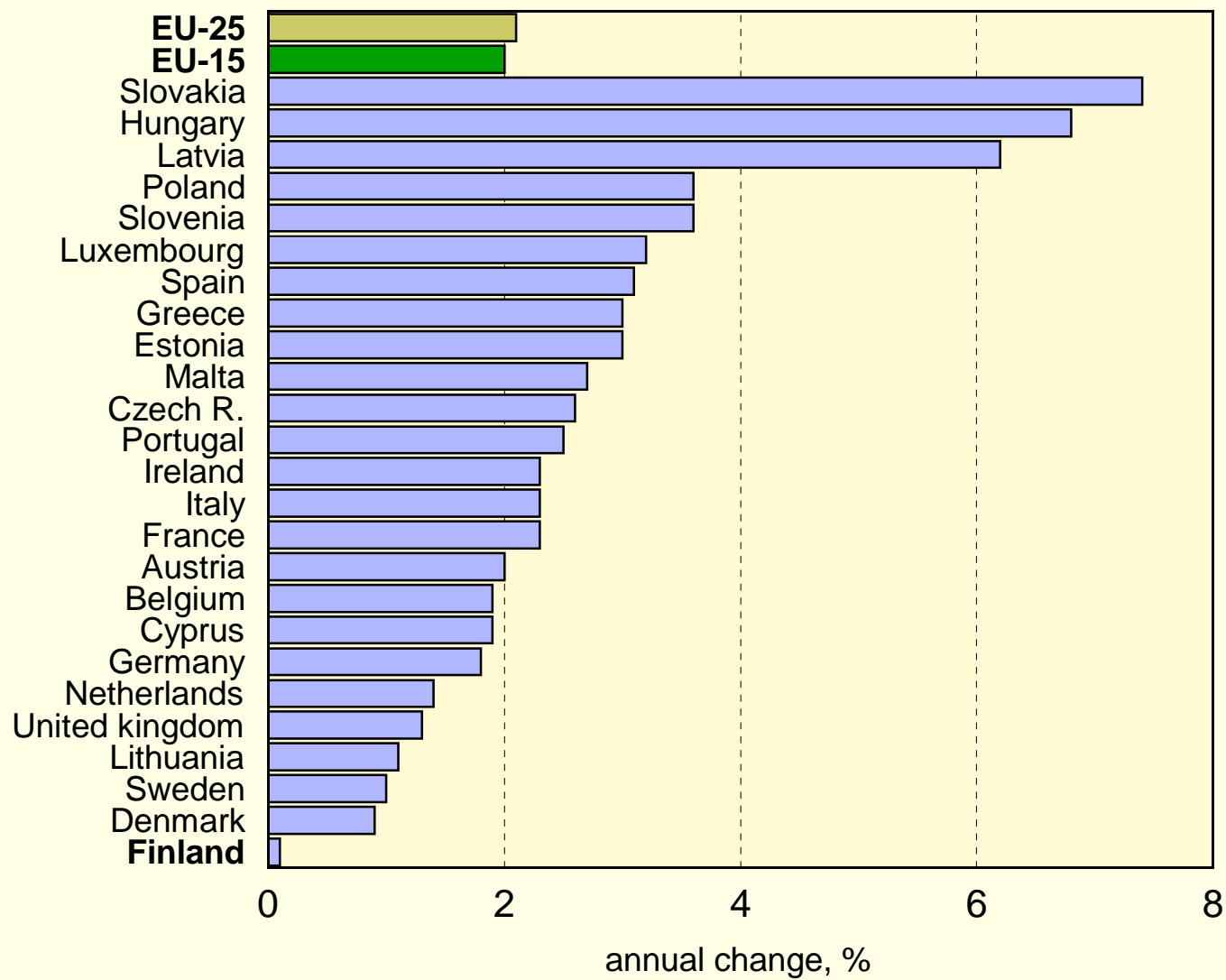
MANUFACTURING PRODUCTION 1985 - 2005



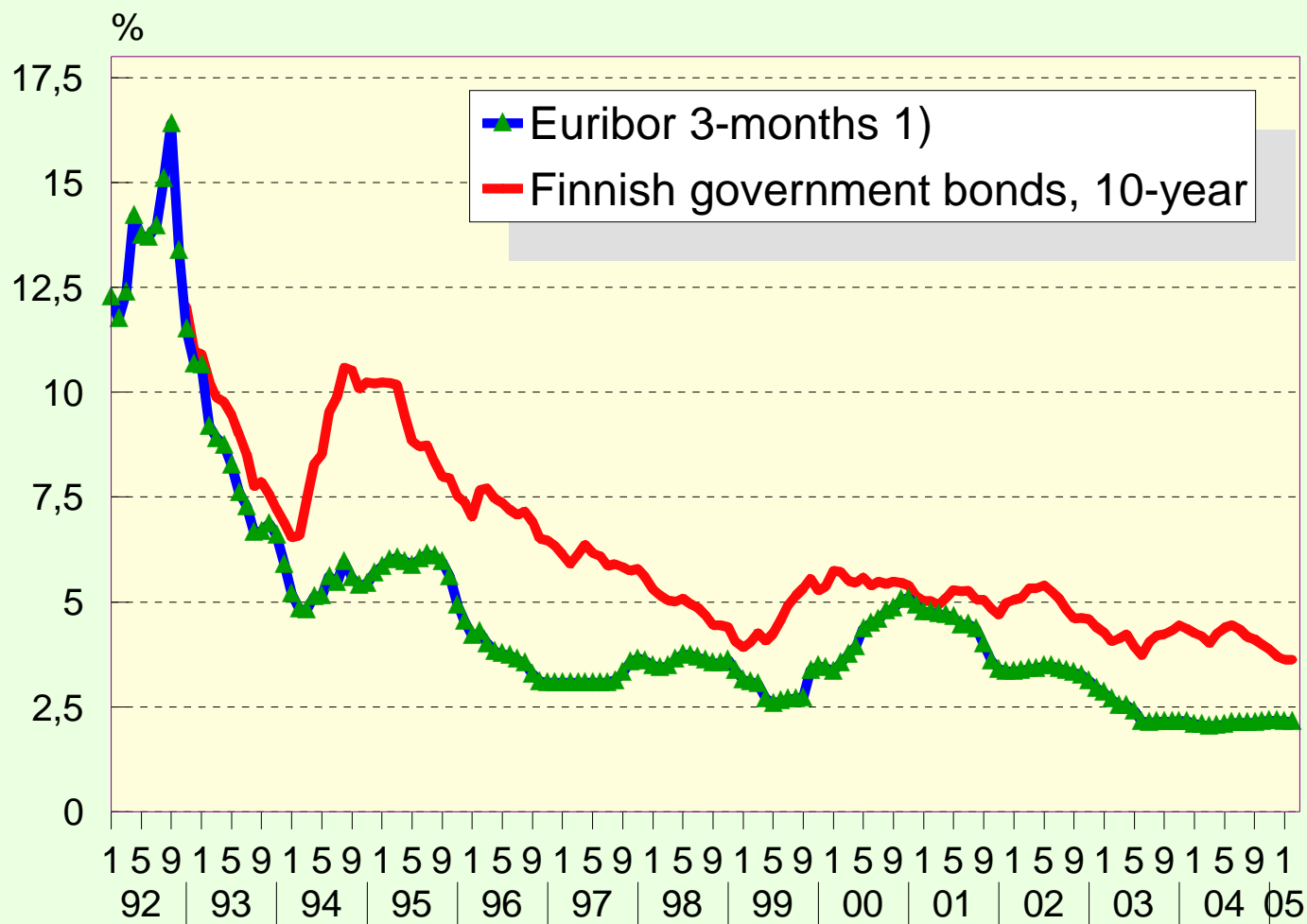
CONSUMER PRICES IN FINLAND AND EU-COUNTRIES 1985 - 2005

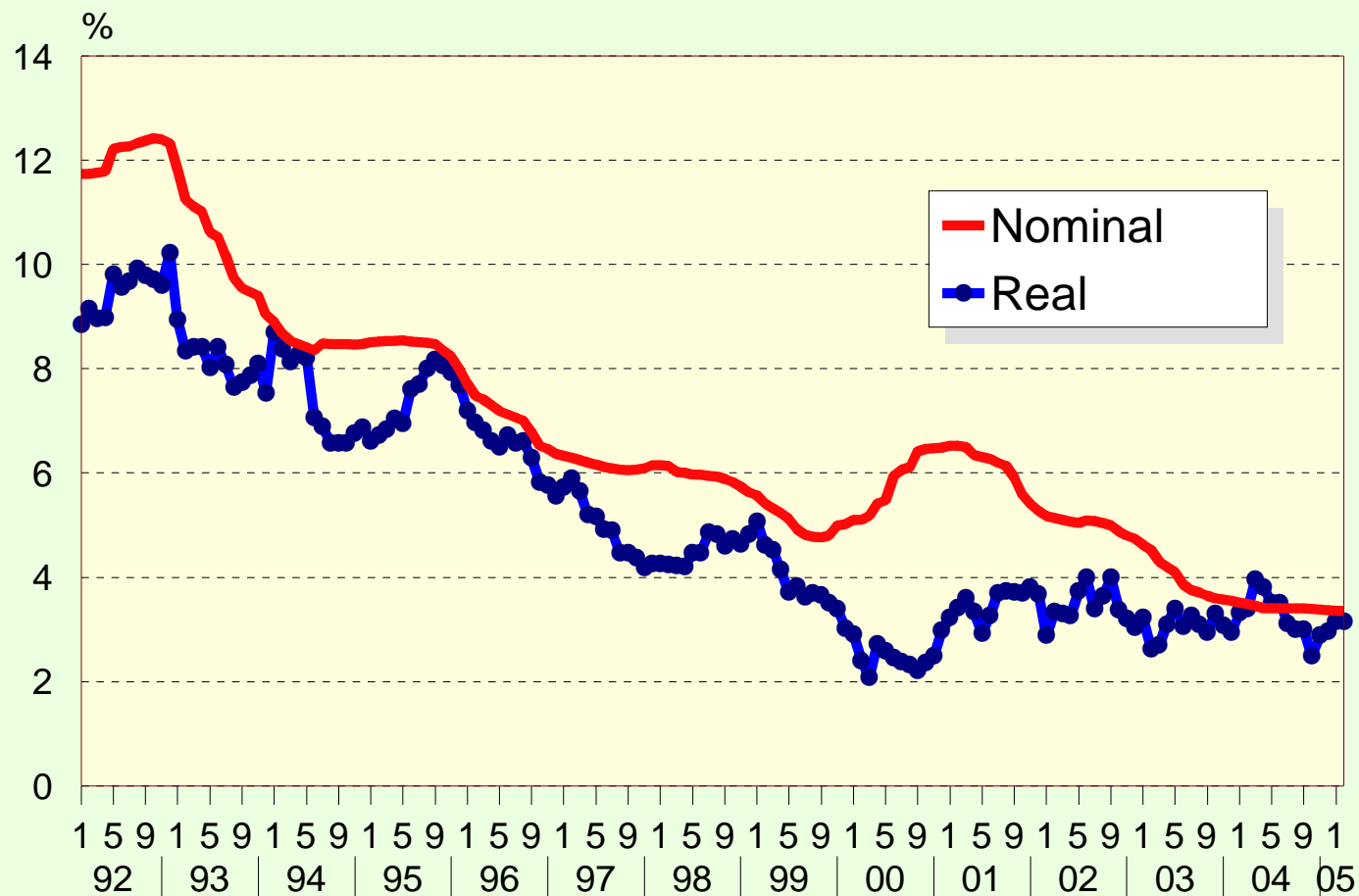

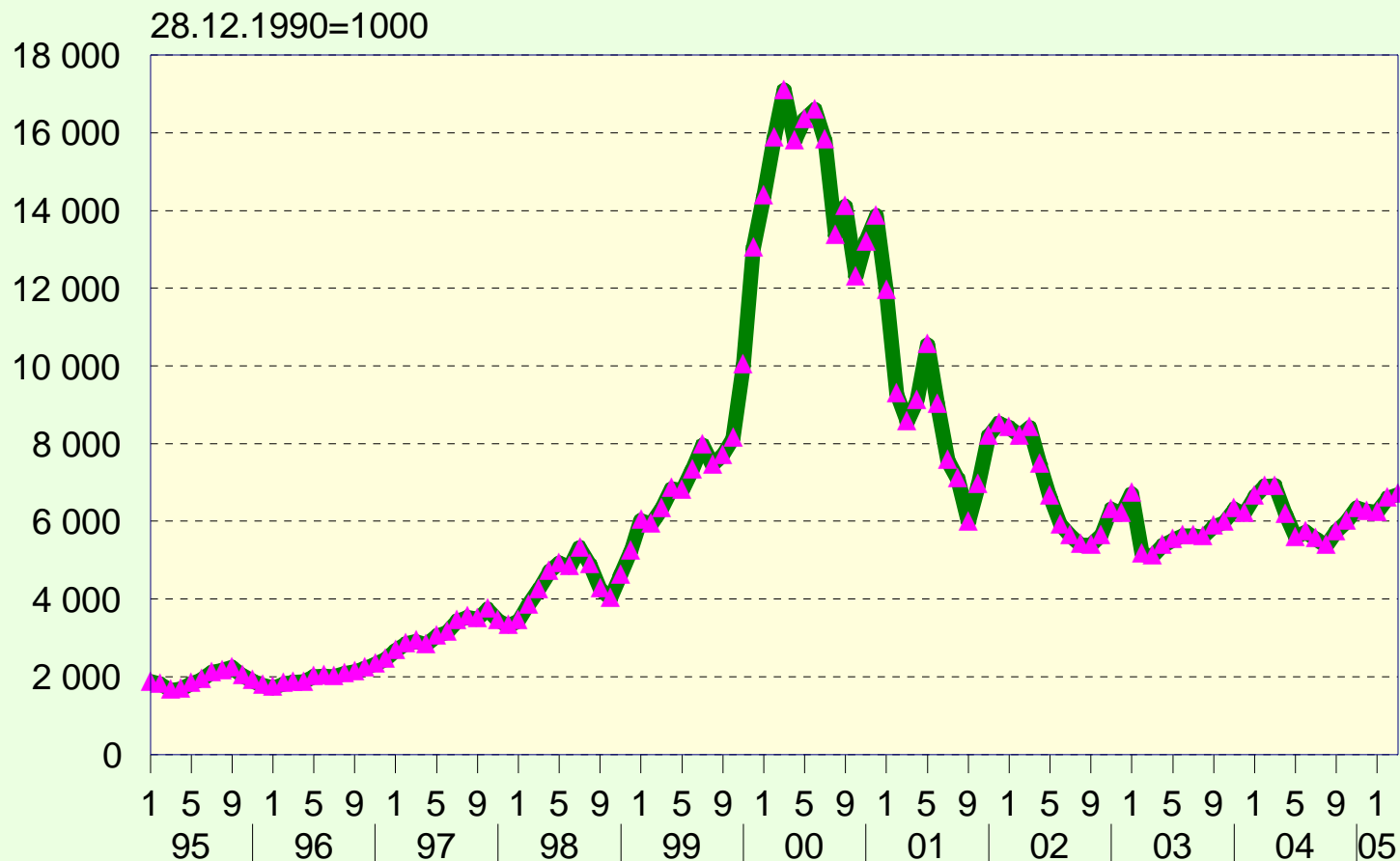

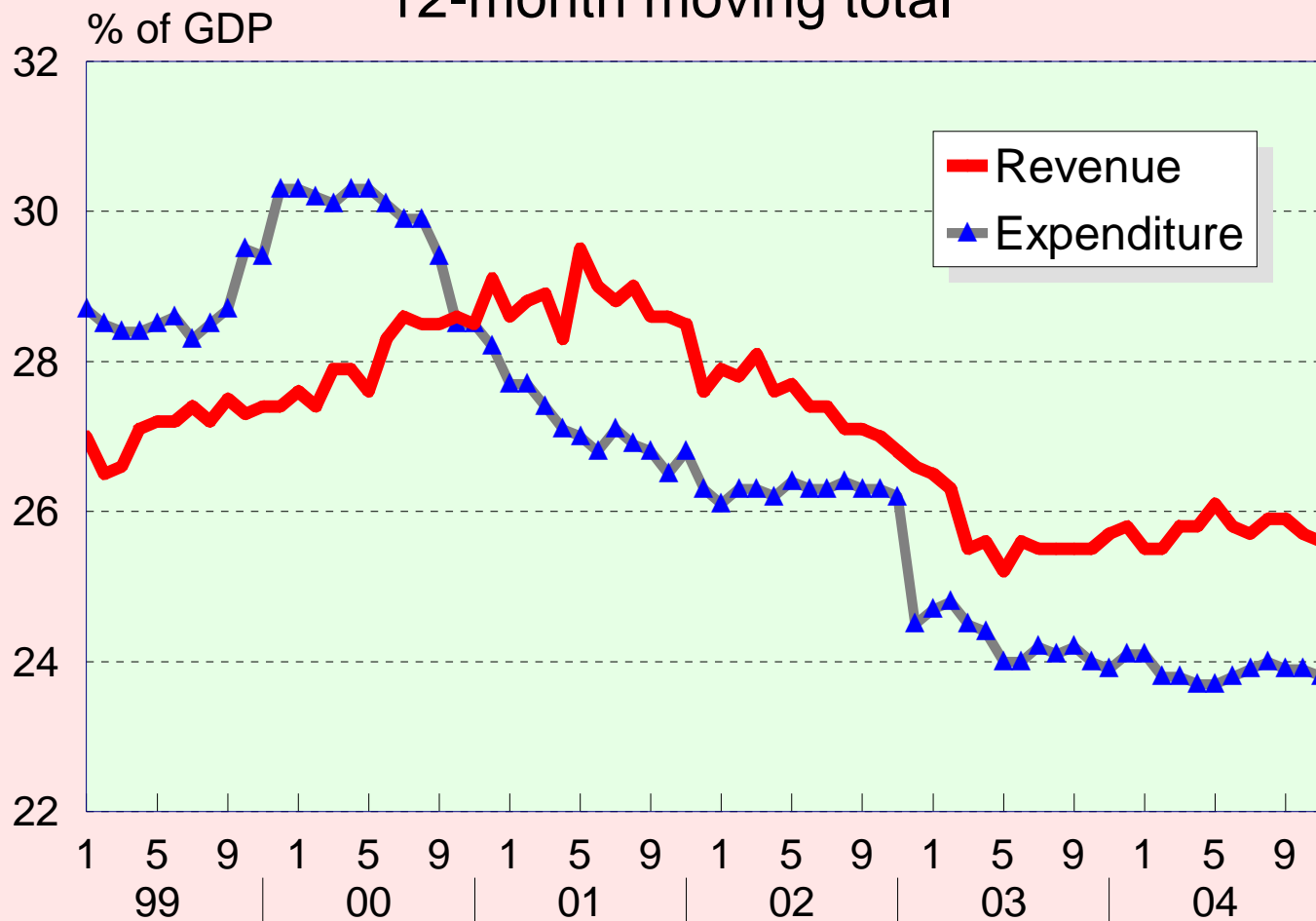
REAL AVERAGE LENDING RATE FOR HOUSING LOANS 1992:1 - 2005:2



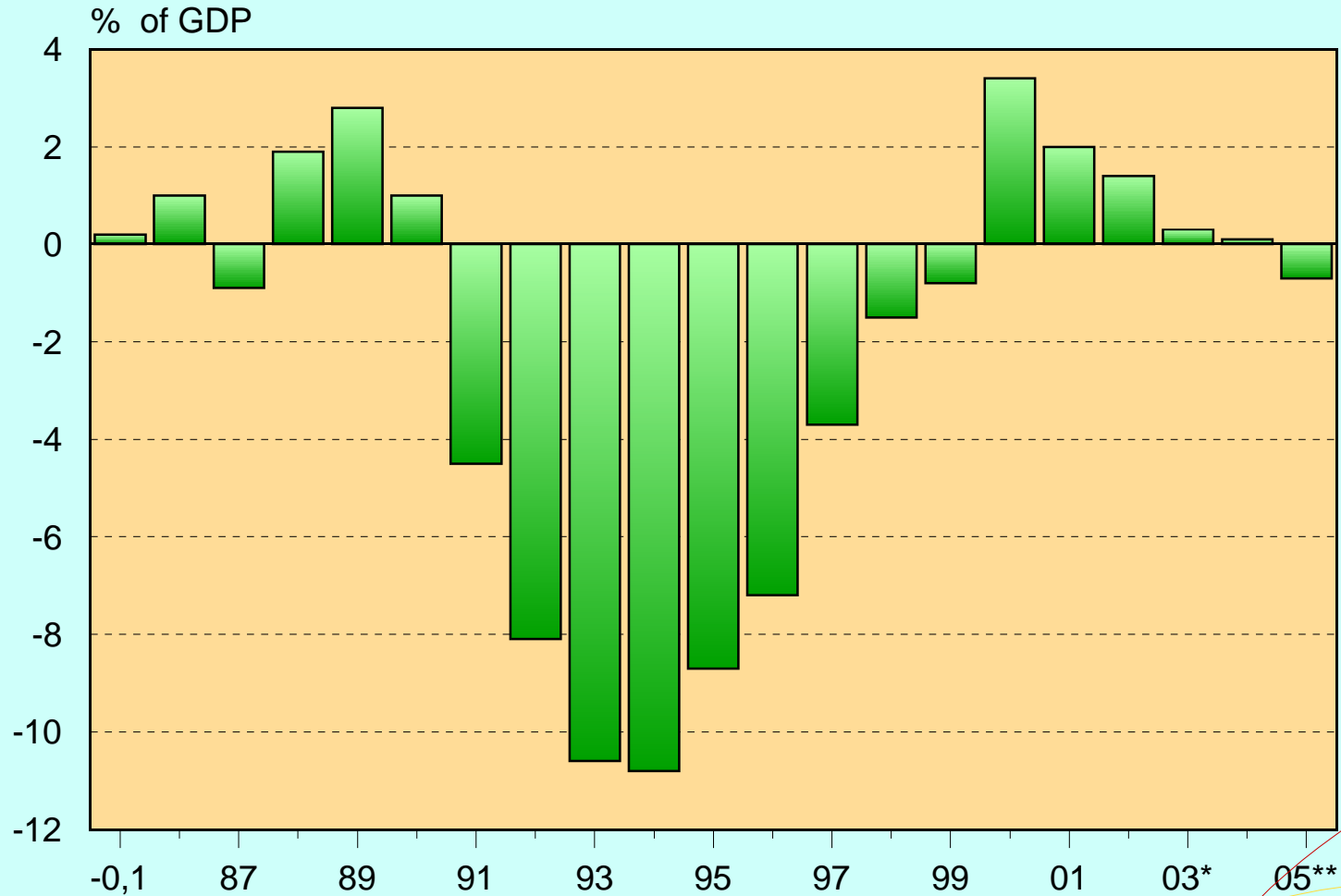
HELSINKI STOCK INDEX (HEX) 1995:1 -2005:2



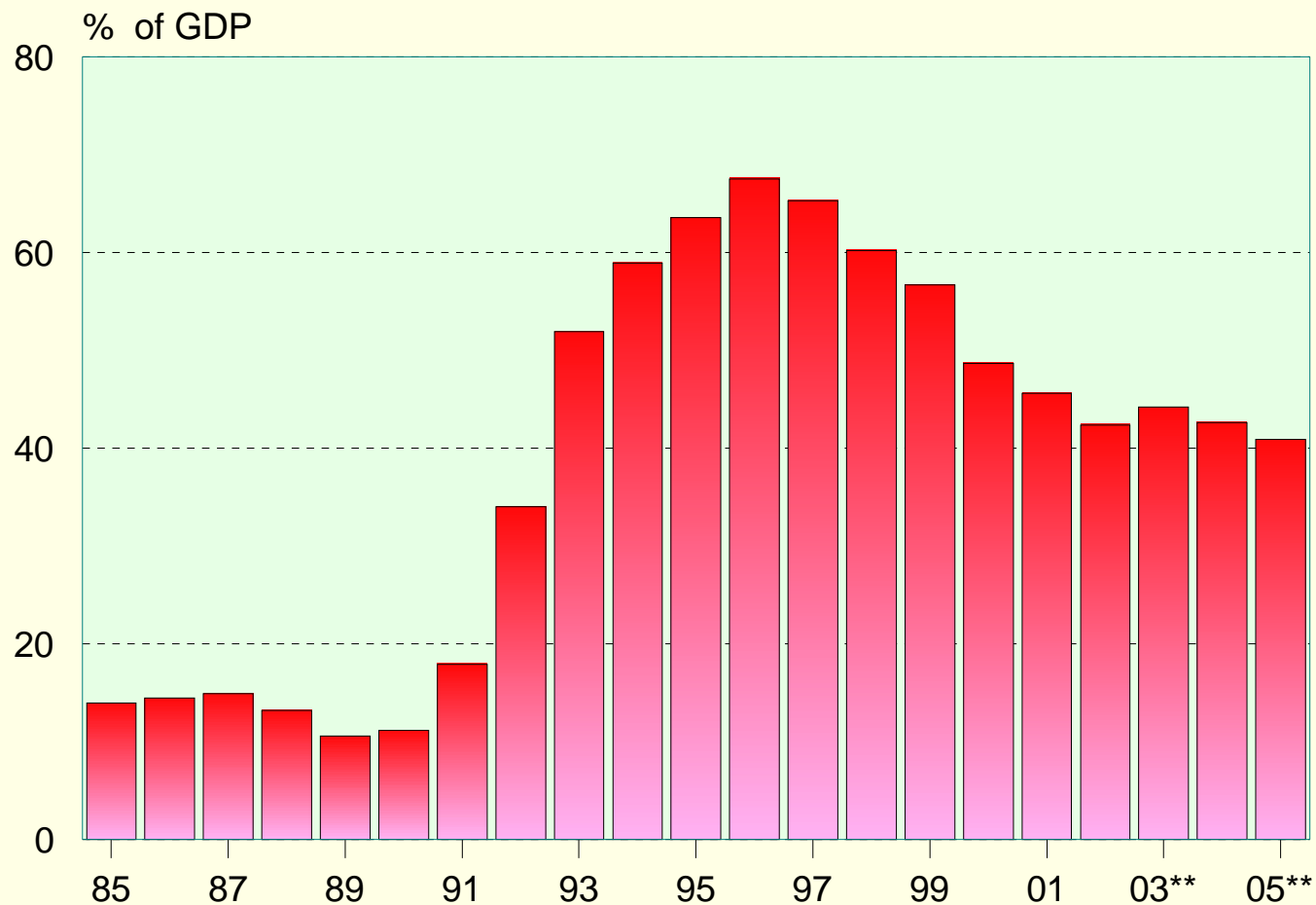

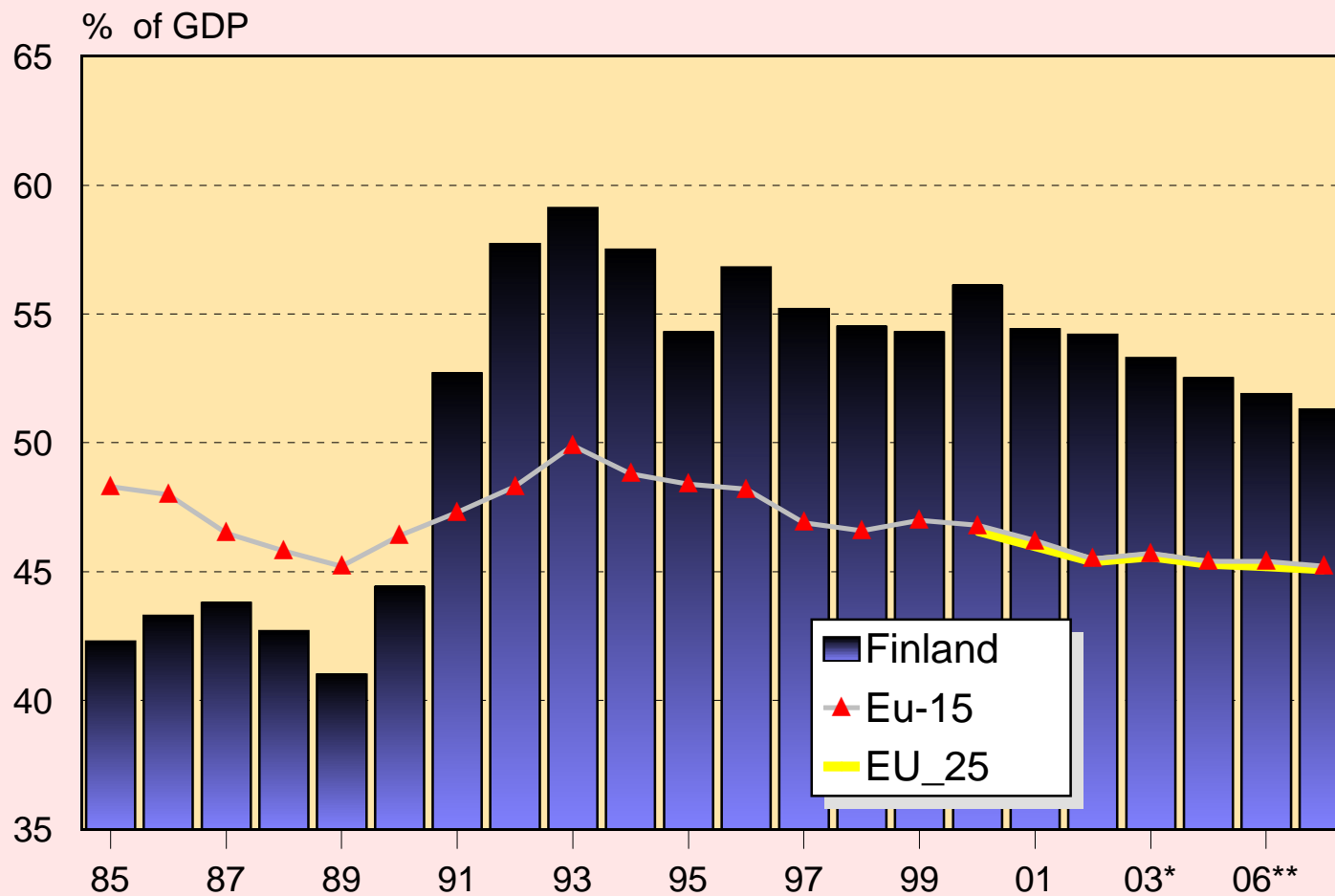
CENTRAL GOVERNMENT NET LENDING 1985 - 2005



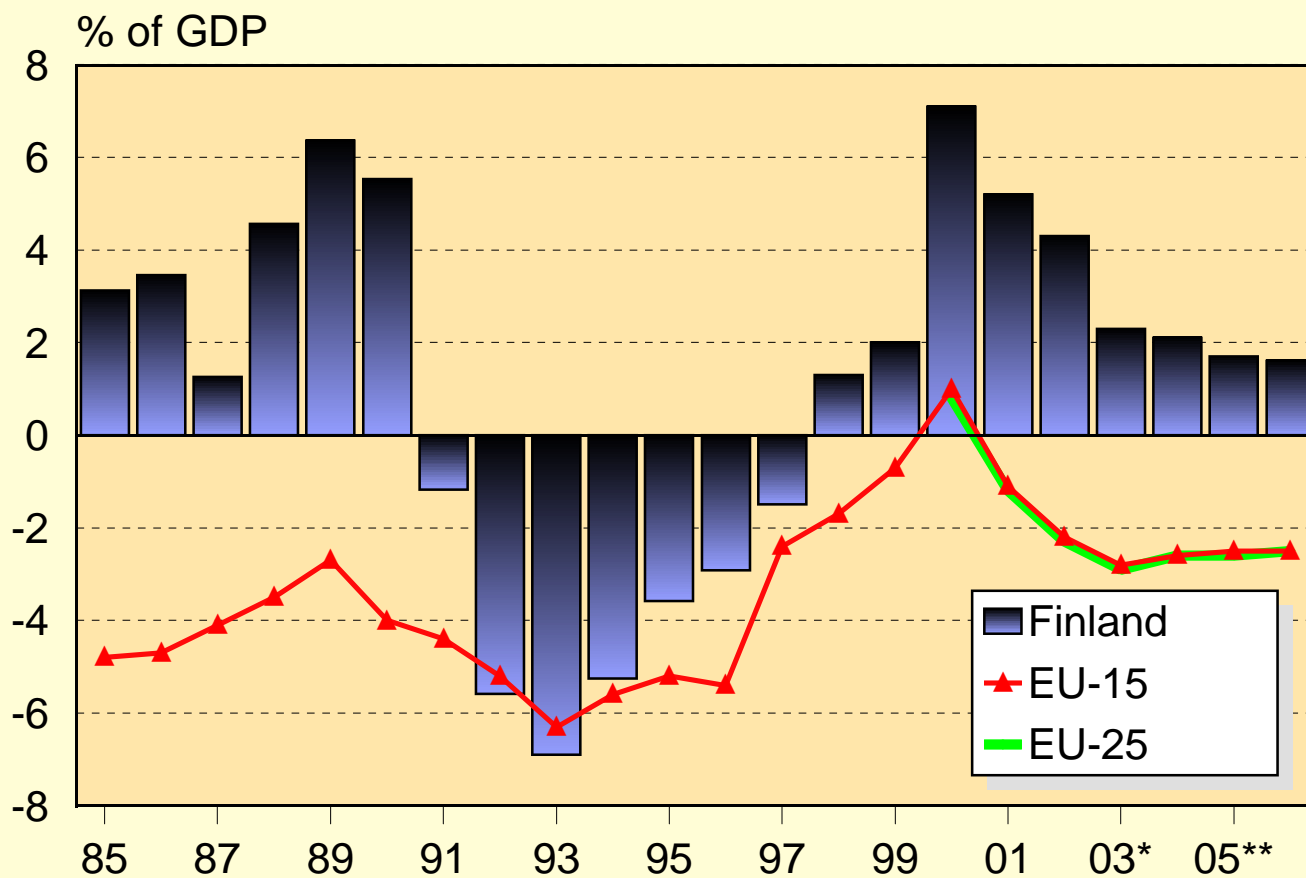
CENTRAL GOVERNMENT DEBT 1985 - 2005



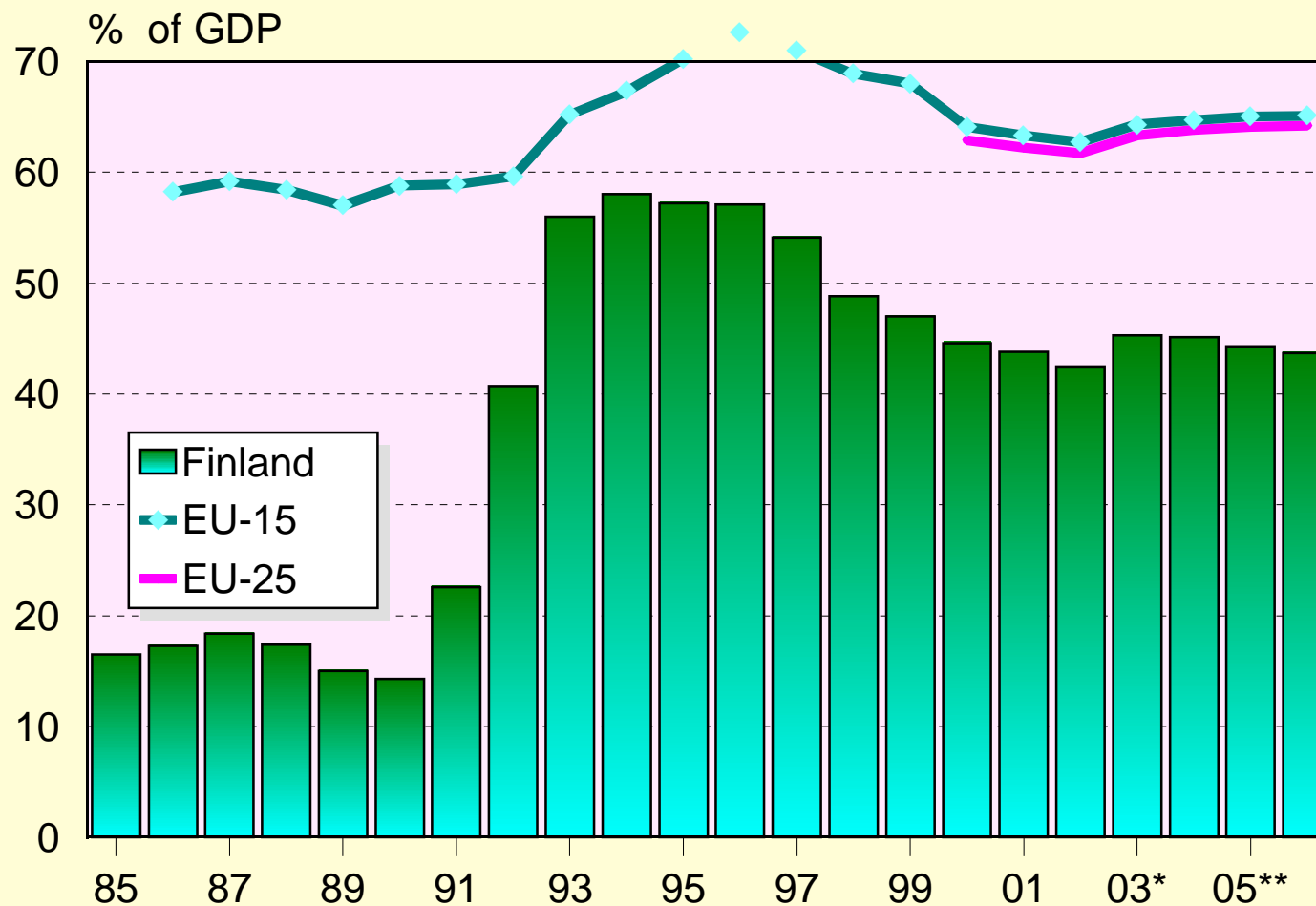
GENERAL GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE 1985 - 2005
